## **General Construction Tips**

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Keep some paper towels handy for cleanup during build.
- 4) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 5) Check the build diagram included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 6) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 7) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 8) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.



# **Build Instructions**


This miniatures storage solution fits inside the Beyond the Grave box for Arcadia Quest. It is designed to handle variable height miniatures, laying and standing, depending on the size. Let's build the main insert and then on the back of this page, you will find the instructions to build the removable miniatures storage tray.


After each piece is placed, you should cleanup excess glue using the provided glue sticks (short, thin wood strips on the base plate). Also, remember to dry fit eveything so you understand where to place glue and how everything fits together.


- 1) Apply glue to the end tab on the interior divider (I) that connects to the inner wall (C) and connect them. Repeat for the other four interior dividers (I).
- 2) Lay the tray base (A) on your workspace. Next, apply glue to the tabs on the bottom of all interior dividers (I) and the bottom tabs on the inner wall (C) and connect the structure to the insert base (A).
- 3) Next, place the inner cross divider (J). A small dot of glue where the inner cross divider intersects the interior dividers (I) will provide a very strong bond. Keep in mind, if you need to lift the insert out of the box, glue is essential when placing the inner dividers. Repeat this step for the other three inner cross dividers (J).
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of long wall (G) and the end tabs of the interior dividers (I) where they connect and place.
- 5) Now, apply glue to the bottom of long side wall (**E**) and the tabs where long side wall (**E**) connects to long wall (**G**) and inner wall (**C**) and place. You may want to place a small amount of glue at the point where long side wall (**E**) and inner cross divider (**J**) meet on long wall (**E**) as well. This will reinforce the insert further. Repeat for the other long side wall (**E**) on the other side.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom of long rear wall (D) and to the tabs that will connect with long side walls (E) and connect them.
- 6) Finally, place glue on the bottom tab of divider (**H**) and in the notches of inner wall (**C**) and long rear wall (**D**) and place. Repeat for the other divider (**H**).

Allow your insert to dry overnight and then place it in your box and place your miniatures.



### **Build Instructions**

The top tray for the AQBTG-001 is used exclusively to store miniatures. You will first build the inner dividers and then place the exterior walls on the tray.

After each piece is placed, you should cleanup excess glue using the provided glue sticks (short, thin wood strips on the base plate). Also, remember to dry fit eveything so you understand where to place glue and how everything fits together.

- 1) Lay the tray base ( $\mathbf{B}$ ) on your workspace. Apply glue to the bottom tabs on the interior divider ( $\mathbf{K}$ ) and place. Repeat for the other four interior dividers ( $\mathbf{K}$ ).
- 2) Next, place the inner cross divider (**L**). A small dot of glue where the inner cross divider intersects the interior dividers (**K**) will provide a very strong bond. Keep in mind, if you need to lift the insert out of the box, glue is essential when placing the inner dividers. Repeat this step for the other three inner cross dividers (**L**).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of long wall (M) and the end tab on interior divider (K) and place. Do the same for the other long wall (M) on the other side.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of long wall (**N**) and to the end tabs that will connect with long walls (**M**) and connect them. You should also place a small amount of glue in the notches where inner cross divider (**L**) intersects the long wall (**N**). Do the same for the other long wall (**N**).

Allow your tray to dry overnight and then place it in your box!
