## **General Construction Tips**

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Keep some paper towels handy for cleanup during build.
- 4) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 5) Check the build diagram included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 6) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 7) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 8) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.

## **Build Instructions**

This miniatures storage solution is designed to fit inside the Guildmaster box for Arcadia Quest. It is designed to handle variable height miniatures. You will first build the inner dividers and then place the exterior walls on the insert.

After each piece is placed, you should cleanup excess glue using the provided glue sticks (short, thin wood strips on the base plate). Also, remember to dry fit eveything so you understand where to place glue and how everything fits together.

- 1) Lay the tray base (A) on your workspace.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom tabs of the inner dividers (D) and place them in the slots provided on the base.
- 3) Next, place the inner cross dividers (**E**). A small dot of glue where the cross divider intersects the inner dividers (**D**) will provide a very strong bond. Keep in mind, if you need to lift the insert out of the box, glue is essential when placing the inner dividers.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of long wall (**C**) and on the end tabs of the inner dividers (**D**) where they join and place. Do the same for the other long wall (**C**) on the other side.
- 5) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of the other long wall (**B**) and to the tabs on each side that will connect with long wall (**C**) and connect them. Do the same for the other long wall (**B**).

Allow your insert to dry overnight and then place it in your box and place your miniatures.
