This tray provides storage for minis and is stored in a Sins box.



General Construction Tips

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Keep some paper towels handy for cleanup during build.
- 4) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 5) Check the build diagram included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 6) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 7) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 8) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.


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
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
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Build Instructions








Please reference the diagrams to understand how each component fits together. Also, dry fit the pieces to understand how it goes together and ensure everything is oriented properly before applying glue. Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish.


Building the Sins Minis Tray

connect to base (A). Repeat on the other side.

Note: ensure the side walls (**C**) are oriented in the same position so that the inner walls (**B**) align properly.

- 1) Place base (A) down on your workspace in the orientation noted to the right.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom of the 5 inner walls (B) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, place glue on the right end tabs of all inner walls (B) and on the bottom of side wall (C) and connect to base (A). Repeat on the left side.
 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and end tabs of end wall (B) and





Placing the Dividers

This tray has six storage lanes that can be divided into smaller compartments using the dividers (**D**, **E**, **F**, **G**). Your tray configuration will depend on what expansions you have and how you decide to store your minis.

As noted in the image on th left, each lane is a specific width and uses a specific divider:

Lane 1: 46mm (divider D)

Lane 2: 41mm (divider E)

Lane 3: 41mm (divider E)

Lane 4: 36mm (divider F)

Lane 5: 28mm (divider G) Lane 6: 28mm (divider G)

Each lane can be divided into as many as four compartments. This design allows for any Sins expansion minis to be stored in this tray. The tallest minis will need to be stored on their side, while most minis will be stored standing.

In addition, these trays can provide storage for acolytes.

Each tray has 8mm of room at the top, allowing for the boards associated with the Sin/acolytes to be stored on top of the tray while the lid rests flat.
