# **AEND-001 STORAGE SOLUTION**

Storage Kit for Aeon's End™ 2nd Edition Core/War Eternal Box (3.35" high internally)

Complete insert kit providing storage for cards, tokens, and counters, with support for the included divider cards



## **Construction Tips**

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.




### **Build Instructions**











Please reference the diagrams to understand how each component fits together. Also, dry fit the pieces to understand how it goes together and ensure everything is oriented properly before applying glue. Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

#### **Building the Breach Tray**

The breach tray is designed to store as many as 30 breaches (from core and expansions) and 8 terror tiles from The Outer Dark.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the right side tab of inner divider (C) and connect long inner divider (B).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom tabs of the structure you built in step #2 and connect to base (A).
- 4) Next, apply glue to both side tabs on long inner divider (B) and the bottom of side wall (F) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the side tab on inner divider (C) and the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (G) and connect.
- **6)** Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (**D**) and connect.
- 7) Finally, apply glue to the small tab on each of the two supports (E) and connect to outer wall (D).







#### **Building the Token Tray**


The token tray is designed to hold tokens from the core game plus expansions.


- 1) Place base (J) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, appy glue to the bottom of inner wall (K) and connect to base (A). Repeat for the other inner wall (K).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of inner wall (L) and connect to base (A).
- **4)** Next, apply glue to point where inner divider (**M**) connects to the other inner walls and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of the inner walls (L, K) and the bottom of outer wall (N) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 6) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of inner divider (M) and the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (O) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 7) After your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place the lid on the tray to ensure a perfect fit and then allow your tray to dry overnight.






#### **Building the Base Insert**


The base insert is designed to be placed inside the game box (2nd edition core/War Eternal) and stores cards. The other trays are stored in the open rectangle in this insert. The game manuals will sit on top of this insert.

- 1) Place glue on the left side tabs of short inner wall (B) and connect to long inner wall (A).
- 2) Next, place glue on the left side tabs of inner wall (A) and connect outer wall (C).
- 3) Next, place glue on the right side tabs of inner wall (A) and connect to outer wall (D).
- 4) Next, place glue on the side tab of short inner wall (B) and the side tabs of outer wall (E) and connect.
- 5) Finally, place glue on the side tabs of outer wall (F) and connect.
- 6) After your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (Z) in the tray to ensure a perfect fit and then allow your tray to dry overnight.

#### **Building the Counter Tray**

The counter tray holds the counter dials and can also provide storage for smaller breaches.

- 1) Place base (J) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom of outer wall (L) and connect.
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tab of end wall (K) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, place glue on the bottom of outer wall (L) and connect.



## Storing Your Trays in the Box

#### **Step One:**

Place your large dashboards (A) in the box as noted on the right and place your counter tray (B) in the empty space inside the rectangle next to the card lanes.

You can store as many as 42 flat dashboards using this solution.



#### **Step Two:**

Next, place your breach tray (C) in the box as depicted in the image.

This tray has three independent supports. The support on the left side requires that you place it in the large open slot and then slide downwards. The counter tray has cutouts to support this tray as well.



#### **Step Three:**

Finally, place your token tray (**D**) in the box stacked on top of the counter tray and the breach tray.
