# **Construction Tips**

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.
- 8) Don't hesitate to reach out to us if you have questions!
- 9) Carefully peel adhesive paper from acrylic parts, as appropriate.



# **Build Instructions**








PLATES #3, 4, 5, 6


Please reference the diagrams to understand how each component fits together. Also, dry fit the pieces to understand how it goes together and ensure everything is oriented properly before applying glue. Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

#### **Building the Top Tray**

The top tray is designed to store the area and management boards, as well as oversized tokens.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the left side tab of short outer wall (C) and connect to inner wall (B). Repeat on the other side.
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom of the structure you built in step #2 and connect to base (A).
- 4) Next, place glue on the right side tab of short inner wall (E) and connect to inner wall (D). Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Next, place glue on the bottom of the structure you built in step #4 and connect to base (A).
- **6)** Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (F) and connect.
- 7) Next, apply glue to the left side tabs of both inner walls ( $\mathbf{B}$ ,
- D), the bottom and side tabs of short outer wall (H), and connect to base (A). Repeat on the other side.
- 8) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs of both short inner walls
- (E) and the bottom of outer wall (G) and connect.






#### **Building the Player Trays**


The four player trays provide dedicated storage for each set of player pieces in the game. These trays also include an acrylic overlay that acts as a lid and allows players to store their warehouse items during play.


Note: you will not need the smaller plates titled ALT1 - ALT3. These plates are used when building the YHAMA-002 for the retail version of the game. You may throw them away.

- 1) Place base (K) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, appy glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner splitter (L) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner splitter (M) and connect to base (A).
- **4)** Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (N) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (O) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- **6)** Finally, after your player tray has had a few minutes to dry, place the acrylic overlay with the adhesive paper still on it into the player tray and allow the tray to dry. This will ensure a perfect fit. You may remove the protective paper on your overlays once your trays have dried totally.
- 7) Repeat these steps to construct the other three player trays.












### **Building the Card Trays**

The two small card trays provide a storage area for small cards and provide convenient deck dispensers during play.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Place glue on the right side tabs of angled floor (B) and connect to outer wall (C).
- **3)** Next, place glue on both side tabs of outer wall (**D**) and connect to the structure you built in step #2.
- **4)** Next, place glue on the left side tabs of angled floor (**B**) and connect outer wall (**C**).
- 5) Next, place glue on the bottom tabs of each outer wall (C) and connect to base (A).
- 6) Finally, place glue on both side tabs and the bottom of outer wall (E) and connect.
- 7) Repeat these steps to build the second card tray.



#### **Building the Setup Card Tray**


The setup card tray provides storage for the achievement cards.

- 1) Place base (G) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Place glue on the bottom of inner wall (H) and connect to base (G). Repeat on the other side.
- 3) Next, place glue on the side tabs of both inner walls (H) and on the bottom of outer wall (I) and connect. Repeat on the other side..

### **Building the Token Trays**

The two token trays provide storage for game tokens and are designed to be placed on the table and used during play.

- 1) Place base (K) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of the three brown colored (see image) inner walls (L) and connect to base (K).
- **3)** Next, place glue on the bottom of outer wall (**M**) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tab of outer wall
- (L) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Repeat these steps to build the second token tray.



# Storing Your Trays in the Box

## **Step One:**

Place two player trays at the top of the box, a token tray below and on the lower left, and then place the two large card dispensers and the small card tray on the lower right.



Next, place the last two player trays on top of the first two and the last token tray on top of the first token tray.

## **Step Three:**

Next, place the top tray on top of the other trays.

## **Step Four:**

Finally, place the score board and the game manual on top and close the box!
