Construction Tips

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.





Build Instructions











Please reference the diagrams to understand how each component fits together. Also, dry fit the pieces to understand how it goes together and ensure everything is oriented properly before applying glue. Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

Building the Player Trays

The player trays are designed to store the four sets of player components (two in each tray). The larger side is for tents/houses you draw as a player action in the game and the smaller side is designed to hold starting components, including dice and tents.

These two trays also have a special cutout at the top to store a score pad. Use the top tray to store your score pad.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation noted on your workspace.
- 2) Next, place glue on the the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the center join and side tabs of divider (C) and connect.
- 4) Next, apply glue to bottom and side tabs of end wall (E) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (D) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 6) Repeat steps #1 #5 to build the second tray.




Building the Resource Trays


The resource trays are designed to store the resources, including the dice and small cardboard tokens. **Note:** two divider walls (**H**) are located on plate #7.


- 1) Lay base (G) down on your workspace. Apply glue to the bottom and both side tabs of the five inner dividers (H) and connect to base (G).
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom of outer wall (J) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom and both side tabs of the end wall (H) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Repeat steps #1 #3 to build the second tray.








Building the Card Tray

The card tray stores all cards (sleeved/unsleeved).

- 1) Place base (A) on your workspace in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the side tabs and bottom of end wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- **3)** Next, place glue on the bottom of outer wall **(C)** and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, place glue on the side tabs and bottom of end wall (B) and connect.





Building the Tile Tray

The tile tray stores the map tiles, dice bags, and large cardboard tokens.

- 1) Place base (E) on your workspace in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the left side tabs of both inner dividers walls (G) and connect to inner wall (F). Note that the inner divider walls (G) must be placed in the proper orientation.
- 3) Next, apply glue to bottom and all side tabs of the structure you built in step #2 and connect to base (E).
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (H) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom of front wall (J) and
- **6)** Finally, apply glue to the bottom of rear wall **(K)** and connect.

After allowing your tray to dry for 5 minutes, place a divider in each of the tile lanes to ensure a perfect fit.

Storing Your Trays in the Box

Step One:

Place the tile tray (A), card tray (D), dice tray (B), and one player tray (C) in the bottom of the box.



Step Two:

Next, place the resource tray (F) and the final player tray (E) on top of the resource and player tray in the configuration shown on the right.



Step Three:

Finally, place the game pad and game manuals on top of the trays and close the box.

This solution contributes zero lid lift with retail and kickstarter components.
