# **Construction Tips**


- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.




#### **Building the Tribe Tray Lids**

You will be constructing eleven (11) tribe tray lids. The tops for the tribe trays are all the same and store the tribe-specific cards. These lids also have a cutout that displays the tribe name. Sleeved cards fit.

**Note:** keep excess glue cleaned up using the glue sticks provided for the tribe lids so that cards slide smoothly when storing.

- 1) Place glue on the bottom tabs of one side wall (B) and connect to top ( $\Delta$ )
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom of divider wall (C) and slide into side wall (A).
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom tabs of the other side wall (B) and connect to top (A)
- **4)** Finally, apply glue to the side bottom tabs of lid bottom (**D**) and on the top tabs of divider wall (**C**) and connect.
- 5) Repeat until you have constructed all eleven (11) tribe tray lids.











#### **Building the Tree Tray**

The tree tray has room to store all base game trees, plus the trees from the Battlegrounds expansion. This tray also offers a small storage compartment for extra dice.


- 1) Place glue on the bottom and side tabs of three small divider walls (G) and connect to base (F).
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom of long wall (H) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 3) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (G) and connect. Repeat on the other side.




#### **Building the Card Tray**


The card tray provides storage for all cards that don't belong to a tribe.

- 1) Place glue on the side tab of base (J) and connect to outer divider wall (K). Repeat on the other side.
- 2) Next, place glue on the side tab of base (J) and side tabs of end wall (L) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 3) Place a couple of dividers in your card tray to ensure it dries and provides a perfect fit when dry.













#### Building the Tribe Tray Bottoms - Um'Rak & Um'Tull


You will build two (2) tribe tray bases using these instructions. Note the orientation of the mini supports (F, Z). They are basically oriented in opposite directions and are different. Placing them correctly matters due to the mini number etchings on the walls.


Note: you will be using the (F, Z) mini supports for these two builds. Also note that one long outer wall (H) and the base (E) have the letter "A" etched. They should join together as noted. Etchings should face inward always!


- 1) Lay base (E) down on your workspace. Apply glue to the bottom and both side tabs of two mini supports (F, Z) and connect to base (E) in the orientation noted on the right.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom of end wall (G) and connect. Repeat on the other side.



- 3) Finally, place glue on the bottom of long outer wall (H) and connect. Note that the etched "A"s on the base (E) and one long outer wall (H) should be together, facing inward. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Place the tribe cards for this tribe in the lid (so you know what tribe the tray is for) and place the lid on the tray to ensure a perfect fit and then allow the trays to drv.
- 5) Repeat the build instructions for the second tribe tray.










#### **Building the Small Token Trays**


You will build two (2) small token trays using these instructions. These token trays rest inside the bases tray and are used to store the interest, tracker, and innocents tokens.

- 1) Lay base (J) down on your workspace. Apply glue to the bottom and both side tabs of wall (K) and connect to the center of base (I).
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom of end wall (L) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 3) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of wall (K) and connect as outer wall. Repeat on the other side.

#### Building the Tribe Tray Bottoms - Bul'Gar


You will build one (1) tribe tray base using these instructions. Note the orientation of the mini supports  $(\mathbf{F}, \mathbf{X})$ . They are basically oriented in opposite directions and are different. Placing them correctly matters due to the mini number etchings on the walls.


Note: you will be using the (F, X) mini supports for this build. Also note that one long outer wall (H) and the base (E) have the letter "A" etched. They should join together as noted. Etchings should face inward always!


- 1) Lay base (E) down on your workspace. Apply glue to the bottom and both side tabs of two mini supports (F, X) and connect to base (E) in the orientation noted on the right.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom of end wall (G) and connect. Repeat on the other side.

Note: each tribe has two etched long outer walls (H) with specific mini numbers etched to aid when loading the trays. One of these walls has an etched "A" and that wall should orient on the same side as the etched "A" on the base (E). Also, the long outer walls (H) are grouped by tribe name. See blue box above!

- 3) Finally, place glue on the bottom of long outer wall (H) and connect. Note that the etched "A"s on the base (E) and one long outer wall (H) should be together, facing inward. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Place the tribe cards for this tribe in the lid (so you know what tribe the tray is for) and place the lid on the tray to ensure a perfect fit and then allow the trays to dry.









#### **Building the Bases Tray**


This tray holds all the mini bases and also stores the two small token trays.


- 1) Lay base (1) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the tabs on support (M) and connect to end wall (K). Repeat on the other end wall (K).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and both side tabs of end wall (K) and connect to
- 4) Next, place glue on the bottom of outer wall (L) and connect. Repeat on the other
- 5) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (K) and connect.



#### **Building the Tribe Tray Bottoms**

You will build eight (8) tribe tray bases using these instructions. Note the orientation of the mini supports (F). They are basically oriented in opposite directions. Placing them correctly matters due to the mini number etchings on the walls.


**Note:** you will NOT be using the (**Y, Z**) mini supports for these eight builds. Also note that one long outer wall (**H**) and the base (**E**) have the letter "A" etched. They should join together as noted. Etchings should face inward!


1) Lay base (E) down on your workspace. Apply glue to the bottom and both side tabs of two mini supports (F) and connect to base (E) in the orientation noted on the right. The mini supports (F) are grouped by tribe name!


2) Next, place glue on the bottom of end wall (G) and connect. Repeat on the other side. Note: Additional end walls (G) are on plate #7.

**Note:** each tribe has two etched long outer walls (H) with specific mini numbers etched to aid when loading the trays. One of these walls has an etched "A" and that wall should orient on the same side as the etched "A" on the base (E).

- 3) Finally, place glue on the bottom of long outer wall (H) and connect. Note that the etched "A"s on the base (E) and one long outer wall (H) should be together, facing inward. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Place the tribe cards for this tribe in the lid (so you know what tribe the tray is for) and place the lid on the tray to ensure a perfect fit and then allow the trays to dry.
- 5) Repeat the build instructions for all eight tribe trays.









#### **Building the Medium Token Tray**

The medium token tray provides storage for the savagery tokens, pillaged tokens, hate tokens, and resource tokens.

- 1) Lay base (J) down on your workspace. Apply glue to the right side tabs of both walls (K) and connect to the center divider (L).
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and all side tabs of the structure you built in step #1 and connect to base (J).
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom of outer wall  $(\mathbf{M})$  and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (L) and connect.
- 5) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (N) and connect.





Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

#### **Building the Huts Tray**

The huts tray is designed to store as many as 30 huts and 21 dice.

- 1) Lay base (A) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the left side tabs of the two inner walls (C) and connect to long inner wall (R)
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of the structure you built in step #2 and connect to base (A).
- 4) Next, place glue on the right side tab and bottom of short wall (**G**) and connect. You will need to carefully angle the wall in to connect into long inner wall (**B**) and base (**A**).
- 5) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of long outer wall (**D**) and connect.
- 6) Next, place glue on the bottom of side wall (E) and connect.
- 7) Next, place glue on the bottom of side wall (F) and connect.
- 8) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of walls (**J**, **I**) and connect them together and then to base (**A**).
- 9) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (H) and connect.








#### **Building the Long Token Tray**

The long token tray token tray provides storage for the savagery tokens, pillaged tokens, hate tokens, and resource tokens

- 1) Lay base (K) down on your workspace. Apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of the three inner walls (L) and connect to the base (K).
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom of long outer wall (M) and connect to base (K).
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom of medium outer wall (N) and connect to base (K).
- 4) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (O) and connect.
- 5) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of the short walls (**P**, **Q**), join them together, and connect to base (**K**).
- 6) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (R) and connect.
- 7) Once the tray has had a few minutes to dry, place the lid on top to ensure a perfect fit once dry.










#### **Building the Small Minis Tray**

The small minis tray is used to store the small mercenary minis. This tray features etched mini numbers for ease of loading the tray.

- 1) Lay base (A) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tab
- of the inner support (C) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tab
- of the inner support (B) and connect to base (A).
- 4) Next, place glue on the bottom of end wall
- $(\mathbf{D})$  and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of etched wall (E). Note that the etching should face inward and 072 should be on the left.
- 6) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (F).







#### **Building the Medium Minis Tray**

The medium minis tray holds ten large minis. **Note:** all etching should face inward! Dry fit this tray and carefully note etching position when building.

- 1) Lay base (**G**) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, place glue on the right side tabs of support (J) and connect to rail (H). See Rail Assemblies figure on the left. Repeat eleven more times! Remove all excess glue for smooth mini storage.
- 3) Next, place glue on the side tabs of the two simple rails (Z) and connect to each end of outer wall (N). Repeat for the other outer wall (L). Remove all excess glue for smooth mini storage.
- 4) Next, place glue on the side tabs of each rail assembly (12x) and connect to the walls (K, L, M, N) as illustrated. Remove all excess glue for smooth mini storage.
- 5) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (K) and connect to base (G).
- 6) Next, place glue on the bottom of outer wall (N) and connect. Repeat on the other side with outer wall (L).
- 7) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (**M**) and connect.








#### **Building the Tall Minis Tray**


The tall minis tray holds twelve large minis. **Note:** all etching should face inward! Dry fit this tray and carefully note etching positions illustrated below when building.

- 1) Lay base (A) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, place glue on the right side tabs of support (J) and connect to rail (H). See Rail Assemblies figure on the right. Repeat thirteen more times! Remove all excess glue for smooth mini storage.
- 3) Next, place glue on the side tabs of the two simple rails (**Z**) and connect to each end of outer wall (**E**). Repeat for the other outer wall (**C**). Remove all excess glue for smooth mini storage.
- 4) Next, place glue on the side tabs of each rail assembly (14x) and connect to the walls (B, C, D,
- E) as illustrated. Remove all excess glue for smooth mini storage.
- 5) Next, place glue on the tabs of the five rests (X) and attach them to each of the walls as illustrated.
- 6) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- 7) Next, place glue on the bottom of outer wall (E) and connect. Repeat on the other side with outer wall (C).
- 8) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (D) and connect.





## Storing Your Trays in the Box



Step One: Place the eleven tribe trays (E), tall mini tray (A), medium mini tray (B), bases tray (C), and the card tray (D) into the box as illustrated.



**Step Two:** Next, place the two small token trays (A) inside the bases tray and then the small minis tray (B) and the medium token tray (C) on top of the medium minis tray on the right.



**Step Three:** Next, place the plateau shaped tiles (**A**, **B**), neatly stacked, as illustrated. Then place the long token tray (**C**). Then place the game manual (**D**) on the right and the huts tray (**E**) and tree tray (**F**) at the top of the box.



Step Four: Next, place the plateau shaped tiles (A, B, C, D), neatly stacked, as illustrated. Then place half of the thick cardstock cards on the right (E).



Step Five: Next, place the chronicle pad (A) on the left and then the village pad (B) on top of it.



Step Six: Finally, place the other half of the thick cardstock cards (A) on the left and close the box!
