Construction Tips


- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.

Building the Card Trays

You will be constructing three (3) card trays.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (C) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom of side wall (B) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (C) and connect.
- 5) Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a couple of dividers in the tray to ensure a perfect fit when dry.
- 6) Repeat until you have constructed all three (3) card trays.








Building the Hero Tray

The hero tray provides storage for your hero cards, as well as smaller terrain tiles.

- 1) Place base (D) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Place glue on the side tab of small inner wall (E) and connect to inner wall (F).
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tab of the structure you built in step #2 and connect to base (**D**).
- **4)** Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (**G**) and connect to base (**D**).
- 5) Next, place glue on the bottom of outer wall (H) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- **6**) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (J) and connect.










Building the Banner Tray

The banner tray is built to store your enemy banner with bases attached.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall
- (B) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom of side wall (C) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall
- (B) and connect.








Building the Large Token Tray

The large token tray is used to store the depletion, person, search/threat, and inspiration/exploration tokens and is intended to be used during play.

- 1) Place base (D) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the side tabs of small inner wall (E) and connect to an inner wall (F) on each side
- **3)** Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of the structure you built in step #2 and connect to base (**D**).
- **4)** Next, place glue on the bottom of end wall (**G**) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (H) and connect. Repeat on the other side.










Building the Small Token Tray

The small token tray is built to store your darkness tokens and has room for additional expansion tokens, if needed.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- **3)** Next, place glue on the bottom of outer wall (**C**) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- **4)** Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of wall (**B**) and connect. Repeat on the other side.








Building the Top Tray

The top tray is designed to store your map tiles and larger terrain tiles. You should place your battle map tiles and game manuals on top of this tray when storing the game.

- 1) Place base (E) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (F) and connect to base (E).
- **3)** Next, place glue on the bottom of side wall **(G)** and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (F) and connect.










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
Building the Shallow Mini Tray

The shallow mini tray will store as many as ten (10) minis each. You will be building two shallow mini trays.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom of end wall (D) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of outer wall
- (E) and connect. Repeat on the other side.

 5) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side to
- 5) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of divider wall (C) and connect (highlighted in purple.) Repeat three more times.
- **6**) Repeat the previous build instructions for the second tray.






Building the Tall Mini Tray

The tall mini tray will store as many as eighteen (18) minis each and the tray is adjustable, allowing you to store larger minis, as needed. You will be building two tall mini trays.

- 1) Place base (F) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (G) and connect to base (F).
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom of side wall (\mathbf{H}) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- **4)** Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (**G**) and connect.
- 5) Once the tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a couple of divider walls (**Z**) to ensure a perfect fit, once dry.
- 6) Repeat the previous build instructions for the second tray.

It is best to wait until you determine how you want to store all of your minis before gluing in the dividers (**Z**) and splitters (**X**, **Y**).

Storing Your Trays in the Box



Step One: Place a shallow mini tray (A), tall mini tray (B), three card trays (C), and small token tray (D) in the box.



Step Two: Next, place a shallow mini tray (A), tall mini tray (B), hero tray (C), and banner tray (D) in the box.



Step Three: Next, place the large token tray (A) in the box.



Step Four: Next, place the top tray.



Step Five: Next, place the battle map tiles on top of the top tray.



Step Six: Finally, place the two game manuals on top of the battle map tiles and close the lid.
