Construction Tips

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.




Build Instructions










Please reference the diagrams to understand how each component fits together. Also, dry fit the pieces to understand how it goes together and ensure everything is oriented properly before applying glue. Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.



Constructing the Base Tray


This tray is designed to store large and small minis and survivor cards.


- 1) Lay base (A) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the right side tabs of the 5x divider walls (C) and connect to inner wall (B).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of inner wall (D) and inner wall (E) and connect to base (A).
- 4) Next, place glue on the bottom of the structure you built in step #2 and connect to base (A).
- 5) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of inner walls (D, E) and on the bottom of outer wall (H) and connect.
- 6) Next, apply glue to the left side tabs of the divider walls (C) and the bottom of outer wall (G) and connect.
- 7) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of inner wall (B) and on the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (F) and connect.
- 8) Next, apply glue on the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (I) and connect. **Note:** check that this wall is oriented properly to allow the placement of the medium splitters (L).
- 9) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs and inner cut where the 4x splitter walls (J) join the 5x divider walls (C) and connect. Repeat for short splitter walls (Z). Short splitter wall (Z) is located on plate #6.


Once the tray has had a few minutes to dry, seat the medium (L) and "U" (K) splitters as illustrated. These splitters are located on plates #6 and #7. Note which mini goes where in the illustration. When storing, rotate your minis until they store without effort.


Once you determine how many survivor cards and which groups of minis you want to store in the large bay that uses the dividers (M, N), you can place those dividers, with or without glue. Divider (M) is on plate #7.




Building the Extra Small Card Tray

This extra small card tray are used to store your small cards. It can be placed in the large bay area of the base tray near the large cards, but it is really intended to be used in the MD-007 tray. If you don't sleeve, you won't need this tray. If you do sleeve, you may benefit from additional card storage, depending on the thickness of your sleeves.

- 1) Lay base (A) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom of end wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- **3)** Next, apply glue to the bottom and both side tabs of side wall (**C**) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of end wall (B) and connect to base (A).

Finally, after allowing the trays to dry for several minutes, you should place a couple of dividers (present in the ZI-001 kit) in the tray to ensure a perfect fit.





Building the Small Minis Tray

This tray is typically used to store survivor minis and BuddyBot.

- 1) Lay base (D) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and both side tabs of the 2x inner walls (E) and connect to base (D). Repeat for inner wall (F).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the points where the 5x splitter walls (G) join the inner walls (E, E, F) and connect.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (H) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of outer wall (J) and connect.
- 6) Next, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of outer wall (K) and connect.
- 7) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs of the 3x small splitters (L) and connect.

Note: the name tab compartment on this tray is for BuddyBot. You can glue his name tab into the tray once you arrange all the minis.
