Storage Organizer for Marvel Champions & 2021 revised FFG LCG core boxes

Organizer kit includes storage for large/small cards and tokens



Construction Tips

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always **dry fit pieces first** to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.

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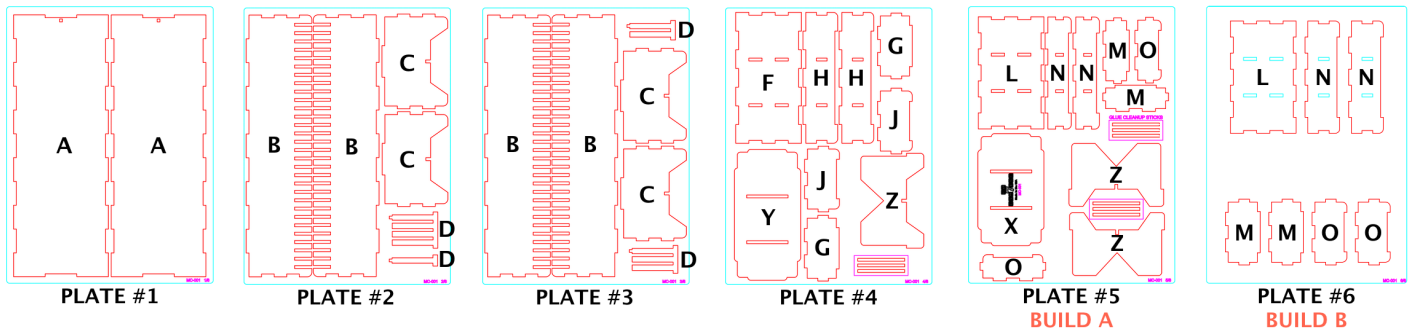

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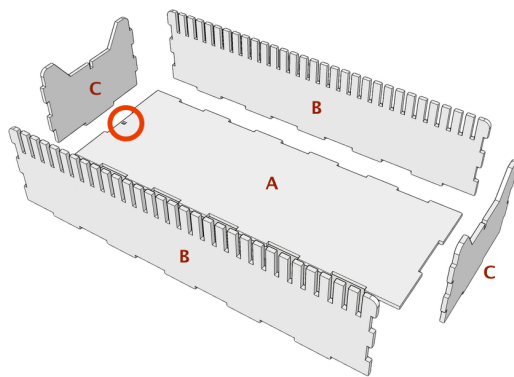
Build Instructions



Please reference the diagrams to understand how each component fits together. Also, dry fit the pieces to understand how it goes together and ensure everything is oriented properly before applying glue. Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

Building the Card Trays (2x)

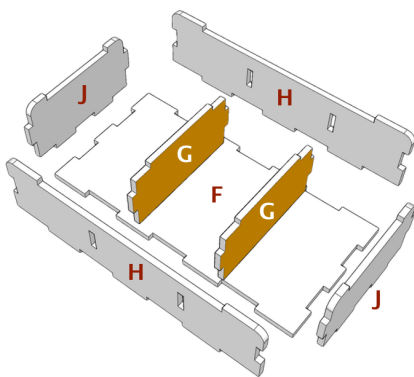
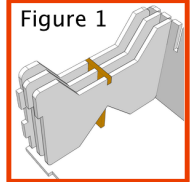
These card trays hold large cards.



- 1) Lay base (A) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom of long wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (C) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of long wall (B) and connect.
- 5) Place a few dividers into the tray to ensure a fit once dry.
- 6) Repeat for the second tray.

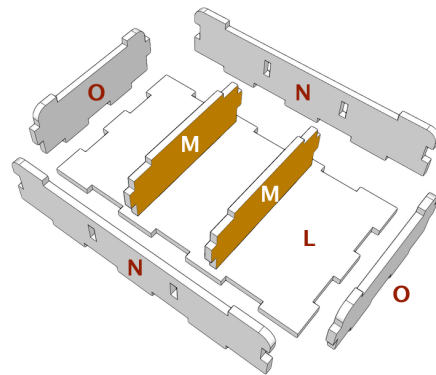
You can use one of the four available splitters (D) to create a small card storage space in the rear of each card tray {see red circle on the left and figure on the right}. The smallest splitter only requires one divider (Z) to create two card spaces. Each larger splitter uses one additional divider and provides two more card spaces. If you sleeve, you may want to make a wider space by removing every other divider. Use a small amount of glue to secure the splitter (D).

Building the Large Token Tray

- 1) Lay base (F) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of both inner walls (G, G) and connect to base (F). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of long wall (H) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (J) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Finally, place the lid (Y) on the tray and allow to dry.



Building the Small Token Tray

This tray has two build alternatives – **Build A** should be used for storing Marvel Champions. **Build B** should be used for Arkham Horror: TCG (2021 revised core) and similar FFG games. The only difference is tray height and the same base and lid is used for both trays, so you can build one or the other, but not both.

Use plate #5 for **Build A** and use plate #6 for **Build B**.

- 1) Lay base (L) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of both inner walls (M, M) and connect to base (L). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of long wall (N) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (O) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Finally, place the lid (X) on the tray and allow to dry.
