Complete insert kit providing storage for minis, cards, tokens, and tiles for Season 2 and KS Extras



Construction Tips

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.








Please reference the diagrams to understand how each component fits together. Also, dry fit the pieces to understand how it goes together and ensure everything is oriented properly before applying glue. Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

Building the Primary Card Tray

The primary card tray is designed to store standard and large episode cards.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation shown.
- 2) Next, place glue on the left side tab of wall (B) and connect to wall (C). {brown}
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of the structure you built in step #2 and connect to base (A).
- 4) Next, place glue on the bottom tabs of rear wall (D) and connect. Note that the etching should face outward!
- 5) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of wall (F) and connect.
- **6)** Next, place glue on the bottom tab of short wall **(G)** and connect.
- 7) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of wall (E) and connect.


Once the tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (**Z**) to ensure a perfect fit once dry.


Building the Large Episode Token Tray


This tray is used to store the episode tokens. Note etching orientations!


- 1) Orient base (I) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, place glue on the left side tab of inner wall (K) and connect to inner wall (J). {brown}
- 3) Next, place glue on the right side tab of inner wall (J) and connect to inner wall (L). {brown}
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of the structure you built in step #3 and connect to base (I).
- 5) Next, place glue on the bottom of inner wall (M) and connect to base (I). {green}
- 6) Next, place glue on the center join and the left tab and connect inner wall (N). {green}
- 7) Next, apply glue to the left side tab of inner wall (J), the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (Q), and connect.
- 8) Next, apply glue to the right side tab of inner wall (K), the right side tab of inner wall (M), the bottom of outer wall (O), and connect.
- 9) Next, apply glue to the side tab of inner wall (N) and the bottom and side tab of outer wall (R) and connect.
- **10)** Finally, apply glue to the left side tab of inner wall (L), the left side tab of inner wall (M), the bottom of outer wall (P), and connect.

Once the tray has had a few minutes to dry, place the tray lid (Y) on the tray and allow the tray to dry overnight.









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Building the Large Monster Tray

This tray is designed to hold the larger and some episodic monsters. Note that all etching should face inwards.


- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation shown.
- 2) Next, place glue on the side tabs of support (F) and glue to walls (D,E). {red}
- 3) Next, place glue on the side tabs of support (G) and glue to outer wall (D). {light blue}
- 4) Next, place glue on the side tabs of floor (I) and glue to outer wall (B). {green}
- 5) Next, place glue on the side tabs of floor (H) and glue to outer wall (C). {yellow}
- 6) Next, place glue on the side tabs of support (L) and glue to rail support (M) and to wall (C). {blue}
- 7) Next, place glue on the side tabs of supports (K,K,K) and glue to double rail support (J) and to wall (D). {purple}
- 8) Next, place glue on the side tabs of support (N) and glue to rail support (O) and to walls (B,B,B,B,C,E).
- 10) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of the wall (B) and connect to base.
- 11) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of the wall (\mathbf{C}) and connect to base.
- 12) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of the wall (D) and connect to base.
- 13) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of the wall (E) and connect to base.


Building the Medium Card Tray


The medium card tray is designed to store the medium episode cards. Each divider is etched with the season/episode number for each set of cards.


- $\textbf{1)} \ \ \textbf{Place base (S)} \ \ \textbf{in the orientation noted}.$
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (T) and connect.
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom of long wall (U) and connect.
- 4) Next, place glue on the bottom of long wall (V) and connect. Note that the etching on this wall should face outwards.
- 5) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (T) and connect.

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (Z) in the tray to ensure a perfect fit once dry.




This elder gods tray provides storage for both Yog-Sothoth and Dagon (KS extra). Note that the etchings should face inward!


- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation shown.
- 2) Next, place glue on the right and left side tabs of splitter wall (D) and connect to walls (B, C). {brown - green - brown}
 - 3) Next, place glue on the bottom of the structure you built in step #2 and connect to base (A).
 - 4) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of short wall (E) and connect to wall (C). Repeat on the other side with wall (B). {blue}
 - 5) Next, place glue on the side tabs of support (K) and connect to inner wall (C). {red}
 - 6) Next, place glue on the side tabs of support (L) and connect to outer wall (G).
 - 7) Next, apply glue to supports (M,N), connect to rail (O), and glue to outer wall (H).
 - 8) Next, apply glue to supports (P,P,Q,R), connect to rail (S), and glue to outer wall (J). {light blue}
 - 9) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of short wall
 - (E) and the bottom of outer wall (F) and connect. Repeat on the other side with outer wall (H).
 - 10) Next, apply glue to the right side tabs of inner wall (B), the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (G), and connect.
 - 11) Finally, apply glue to the left side tabs of inner wall (C), the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (J), and connect.


Building the Small Monster Tray


This tray provides storage for season 2 monsters and some episode minis. Note that the etchings should face inward!

- 1) Orient base (T) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom of support (U) and connect to base (T). Repeat on the other side. {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to support (3), connect to rail (4), and connect to left outer wall (X). {light blu
- 4) Next, apply glue to support (3), connect to rail (5), and connect to right outer wall (X) on the other side. {green}
- 5) Next, apply glue to supports (Z,Z,Z,Z), floor (1), multi-rail (2), and connect to outer wall (W). {blue}
- 6) Next, apply glue to supports (**Z,Z**), floor (6), rail (7), and connect to outer wall (V). {purple}
- 7) Next, apply glue to support (Z), floor (6), rail (8), and connect to outer wall (V). {red
- 8) Next, apply glue to the side tab of support (U) and the bottom of outer wall (V) and connect. Repeat on the other side with outer wall (W).
- 9) Next, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of outer wall (X) and connect. Repeat on the other side with the other outer wall (X).

Building the Small Minis Tray

This tray is designed to store your investigators and other small monster minis. Etchings are provided for monster storage guidance. Note that etchings face inward.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation shown.
- 2) Next, place glue on the side tabs of the two supports (K) and glue to wall (D). {red}
- 3) Next, place glue on the side tabs of supports (F,F,F,F,F) and glue to rail support

(H) and to wall (B). {purple}

4) Next, place glue on the side tabs of support (F) and glue to rail support (J) and to wall (C). Repeat for the other wall (C). {blue}

5) Next, place glue on the side tabs of supports (F,F,F,F) and glue to rails (G,G,G,G) and to wall (D). {brown}


- 6) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- 7) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of wall (C) and connect to base.
- **8)** Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of wall (**C**) and connect to base.
- 9) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of wall (D) and connect to base.




Building the Small Episode Token Tray


This tray is used to store the episode tokens. Note the etchings face inward.


- 1) Orient base (S) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom of inner wall (T) and connect to base (S). {brown}
- 3) Next, place glue on the side tabs of cross wall (U) and connect. {brown}
- 4) Next, place glue on the side tabs and bottom of wall (W) and connect.
- 5) Next, place glue on the left side tab of inner wall (T) and the bottom of wall (V) and connect.
- **6)** Next, place glue on the bottom of wall (**X**) and connect.
- 7) Finally, place glue on the side tabs and bottom of outer wall (Y) and connect.











Building the Goat Elder God Tray (Optional)

The Goat elder god tray is designed to store all elder god components. Etchings face inward.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation shown.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom of inner wall (B) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom and left side tabs of short wall (C) and connect. {brown}
- 4) Next, place glue on the side tabs of support (L), connect to rail (M), and connect to outer wall (G). {light blue}
- 5) Next, place glue on rail (K) and connect to outer wall (F). Repeat on outer wall (E). {red}
- 6) Next, place glue on the side tabs of support (O), connect to rail (P), and connect to outer wall (F). Repeat on inner wall (B). {pink}
- 7) Next, place glue on the side tabs of supports (L,L), connect to rails (N,N), and connect to outer wall (F) {blue}
- 8) Next, place glue on the side tab of floor (H) and connect to outer wall (F). Repeat on inner wall (B) with the second floor (H). {green}
- 9) Next, place glue on the side tabs of inner wall (B), the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (G), and connect to base (A)
- **10)** Next, place glue on the side tabs of short wall (**C**), the bottom of outer wall (**D**), and connect.
- 11) Next, place glue on the side tabs and bottom of outer wall (E) and connect.
- 12) Next, place glue on the bottom of outer wall (F) and connect.




Building the Goat Elder Tray Lid (Optional)

This lid is used to convert your Goat elder tray into an external tray solution. This is only needed if you don't use your third large box to store the player trays and the elder god tray for Goat.

- 1) Place base (R) in the orientation shown.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of outer wall (S) and connect to base (R).
- **3)** Next, apply glue to the bottom of end wall (**T**) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of outer wall (S) and connect.


Once your lid has had a few minutes to dry, place it on the top of your Goat tray to ensure a perfect fit and allow it to dry overnight.



Storing Your Trays in the Box

Step One: Place the medium card tray (A), large episode token tray (B), small monster tray (C), primary card tray (D), small minis tray (E), large monster tray (F), and the double Elder Gods tray (G) into the box as illustrated.

Note: you can substitute the Goat Elder Gods tray in place of the double Elder Gods tray.



Step Two: Place the small episode token tray (**A**) and the setup tray (**B**) into the box as illustrated and close.



Optional: This organizer offers one optional tray used to store the Goat Elder God minis. This tray is the same size as the double Elder Gods tray. Only one of these will fit with the other trays in the box. The optional tray can be used externally, by using the provided lid, or you can store the tray in your third box (along with your plastic dashboard trays), assuming you backed the Kickstarter and bought Season 2.
