Construction Tips

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.







Building the Small Card Tray

The Small Card Tray is designed to store small cards, sleeved or unsleeved, from expansions.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of base (A), the side tabs of end wall (B), and connect to base (A). Repeat on the other side.
- 3) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs of base (A) and connect long wall (C). Repeat on the other side.

Once the tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (Z) in the tray to ensure a perfect fit once dry.




Building the Medium Card Tray

The Medium Card Tray is designed to store medium cards, sleeved or unsleeved, from expansions.

- 1) Orient base (D) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of base (D) and connect to long wall (E). Repeat on the other side.
- 3) Finally, apply glue to the side tab of base (D), the side tabs of end wall (F), and connect. Repeat on the other side.

Once the tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (Y) in the tray to ensure a perfect fit once dry.




Building the Large Card Tray


The Large Card Tray is designed to store large cards, sleeved or unsleeved, from expansions.


- 1) Orient base (G) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (H) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of long wall (J) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (H) and connect.


Once the tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (X) in the tray to ensure a perfect fit once dry.



Building the Main Insert


The Main Insert provides storage for 36 minis, additional small/medium/large cards, and additional upgrade tiles.


Note: dry fit this tray and ensure you have all the walls placed properly PRIOR to gluing together.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the left side tabs of inner walls (C, C), connect to outer wall (B), then apply glue to the right side tabs of outer wall (B) and connect to long wall (D). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of the structure you built in step #2 and connect to base (A).
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (E) and connect. {green}
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (F) and connect. {orange}
- 6) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (G) and connect. {yellow}
- 7) Next, apply glue to side tabs and bottom of outer wall (K) and connect.
- 8) Next, apply glue to side tabs and bottom of outer wall (L) and connect.
- 9) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (H) and connect.
- 10) Next, apply glue to side tabs and bottom of outer wall (J) and connect.
- 11) Next, apply glue to the bottom of splitters (M, M, M, M) and connect. {blue}
- 12) Next, apply glue to the bottom of splitters (O, O, O, O) and connect. {black}
- 13) Next, apply glue to the bottom of splitters (P, P, P) and connect. {cyan
- 13) Next, apply glue to the bottom of splitters (N, N) and connect. {purple}
- 13) Next, apply glue to the bottom of splitter (T) and connect. {red}
- 13) Next, apply glue to the bottom of splitters (R, R) and connect. {purple-blue}
- 14) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of splitter (S) and connect.





Building the Upgrade Tile Tray

The Upgrade Tile Tray provides additional tile storage for the upgrade tiles that are included in the expansions (not Showdown tiles).


- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the side tab of base (A) and connect to outer wall (B). Repeat on the other side.
- 3) Finally, apply glue to the side tab of base (A), the side tabs of end wall (C), and connect. Repeat on the other side.

Once the tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (Z) in the tile tray to ensure a perfect fit once dry.



Storing Your Trays in the Box

Step One: Place the Main Insert (A), Large Card Tray (B), Medium Card Tray (C), Small Card Tray (D), and Upgrade Tile Tray (E) into the box.



Step Two: Finally, place three expansion campaign pads (**F**) in the cutout area of the Main Insert (**A**) and close the box.
