Storage Solution for Starcadia Quest Showdown

Complete insert kit providing storage for cards, tiles, Scenery Pack, and more



## **Construction Tips**

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.





### **Build Instructions**






Please reference the diagrams to understand how each component fits together. Also, dry fit the pieces to understand how it goes together and ensure everything is oriented properly before applying glue. Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

#### **Building the Upgrade Tile Tray**

The Upgrade Tile Tray provides storage for all of the upgrade tiles in the Showdown expansion.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (C) and connect to base (A).
- **3)** Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (**B**) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (C) and connect.

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (Z) in the tray to ensure a perfect fit.




#### **Building the Card Trays**

These two (2) Card Trays are designed to store the Showdown cards, sleeved or unsleeved.

- 1) Orient base (E) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to left side tab of base (E) and the side tabs of end wall (G) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 3) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of base (E) and then connect outer wall (F). Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Repeat steps #1-3 and build the second Card Tray.


Once your card trays have had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (X) to ensure a perfect fit.




#### **Building the Small Token Tray**


This Small Token Tray is used to store the tokens for Showdown (portals, stimpack, recharge).

- 1) Orient base (J) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (K) and connect to base (J). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (M) and connect.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (L) and connect.
- 5) Finally, apply glue to bottom and side tabs of outer wall
- (N) and connect. Repeat on the other side with outer wall (O).

#### **Building the Main Insert**


The Main Insert provides storage for the Scenery Pack, Showdown bag, and some overflow storage for extra dice and excess tokens.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B, C, C) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (D) and connect.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (E) and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (F) and connect.
- 6) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall ( $\mathbf{G}$ ) and connect.

Because this tray provides overflow storage for Scenery components, these next steps are optional and variable depending on whether you own the Scenery Pack.

7) Next, apply glue to bottom and side tabs of the divider walls (H, H, H, H, H) and connect. {red}

8) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of large divider(s) (J, J) and connect. The dividers (J, J) can both be used to create three compartments or only one can be used to create two compartments. {blue}



# Storing Your Trays in the Box



Step One: Place the Main Insert (A), Card Trays (B, B), Token Tray (C), and Upgrade Tile Tray (D) into the box.



**Step Two:** Finally, place the Showdown dashboards, double-sided game board, and game manual (E) on top of the insert.
