Construction Tips

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.







Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

Building the Player Tray

The Player Tray is designed to store the player components.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (B) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of end wall (C) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (D) and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (E) and connect.
- **6)** Finally, apply glue to the bottom of the three splitters (**F**, **F**, **F**) and connect. {purple}

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, attach lid (Z) and allow it to dry.




Building the Play Tray #1

The Play Tray #1 is designed to store the coins, damage tokens, and shame tokens for use during play.

- 1) Orient base (H) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (J) and connect to base (H). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of wall (K) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (L) and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (M) and connect.
- 6) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of splitter (N) and connect. {purple}

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, attach lid (Y) and allow it to dry.




Building the Play Tray #2


The Play Tray #2 is designed to store the threat (base), potion (base), and madness tokens (expansion) for use during play.


- 1) Orient base (O) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls
- (P, P) and connect to base (O). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of wall (R) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- **4)** Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls (**Q**, **Q**) and connect.


Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, attach lid (\mathbf{X}) and allow it to dry.






Building the Card Tray

The Card Tray is designed to store the cards and also provides a place to store the Dice Tray and Player Tray.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (C) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of wall (B) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (C) and connect.

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a couple of dividers (**Z**) in the tray to ensure a perfect fit while the tray dries.







Building the Dice Tray


The Dice Tray is designed to store a bunch of dice.

- 1) Orient base (E) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue on the bottom and side tabs of wall (G) and connect to base (E).
- **3)** Next, apply glue on the bottom of wall (F) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- **4)** Finally, apply glue on the bottom and side tabs of wall **(G)** and connect.



Building the Main Insert

The Main Insert is designed to store your minis and provide a nice resting place for other trays, game boards, manuals, character dashboards, and more.


- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of the four supports (F, G) and connect to walls (M, N, B, O). {red}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of the three supports (J, K) and connect to wall (M). {purple}
- 4) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of the three supports (H, H, H) and connect to walls (M, N, O). {orange}
- 5) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of support (L) and connect to wall (P). {yellow}
- 6) Next, apply glue to the left side tabs of divider walls (C, C, D) and connect to inner wall (B) and then apply glue to the bottom of this structure and connect to base (A). {brown, brown, green}
- 7) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitter walls (E, E, E) and connect. {blue}
- 8) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (O) and connect.
- 9) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (P) and connect.
- 10) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (\mathbf{M}) and connect.
- 11) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (N) and connect.



Storing Your Trays in the Box

Step One: Place the Main Insert (**A**), Dice Tray (**B**), Player Tray (**C**), and Card Tray (**D**) into the box as illustrated.

The Player Tray and Dice Tray are designed to store in the Card Tray (**D**).



Step Three: Finally, place the game board on top of the organizer and then place ALL character dashboards, bookmarks, expansion boards, and rulebooks on top of the trays and close the box.
