EVER-001-UPGRADE SOLUTION

This kit upgrades our EVER-001 replacing the card tray and providing four new trays, supporting the storage of Everdell expansions (Pearlbrook, Bellfaire, Spirecrest)



Construction Tips

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.

Building the Card Tray

This tray is used to store your cards and the 10 point wonder. This card tray replaces the card tray currently in your organizer.

- 1) Lay base (A) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the left side tab of divider wall (C) and connect to inner wall (B). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of the structure you built in step #2 and connect to base (A).
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of the two inner walls (D, D) and connect. {green}
- 5) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of inner walls (D, D, B) and the bottom of outer wall (E) and connect.
- 6) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (D) and
- 7) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (F) and connect.
- 8) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (B) and connect.







Building the Small Player Tray

The Small Player Tray is designed to store the rest of the player components from all the expansions.

- 1) Lay base (H) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of divider walls (N, J, J, J) and connect to base (H). {green} {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the point where the walls join and connect the two splitter walls (L, L). {red}
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of side wall (M) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of outer wall (O) and connect.
- 6) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of outer wall (N) and connect.







Building the Map Tiles Tray

The Map Tiles Tray is designed to store the map tiles, axolotl tokens, signs (unbuilt), and die.

- 1) Lay base (A) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the right side tabs of divider walls (C, C) {orange} and the left side tabs of divider walls (D, D, D) {red} and connect to inner wall (B). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of the structure you built in step #2 and connect to base (A).
- **4)** Next, apply glue to the side tabs of divider walls (**D**, **D**, **D**) and the bottom of outer wall (**G**) and connect. Repeat on the other side with divider walls (**C**, **C**) and outer wall (**F**).
- 5) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of outer wall (E) and connect. Repeat on the other side.





Building the Garland Tray


The Garland Tray is designed to store the garland tiles and the 25 point wonder.

- 1) Lay base (J) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of divider wall (K) and connect to base (J). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (L) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of outer wall (K) and connect. Repeat on the other side.

Building the Big Critter Tray

The Big Critter Tray is designed to store the big critters, saddles, and the market tokens.

- 1) Lay base (N) down on your workspace.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of divider walls (O, O) and connect to base (N). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (P) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of outer wall (O) and connect. Repeat on the other side.



Storing Your Trays in the Box



Step One: Place the Card Tray (A), Large Player Tray (B), and four Token Trays (C) into the box as illustrated.

Step Two: Place the Garland Tray (**D**), Small Player Tray (**E**), Map Tiles Tray (**F**), and Big Critter Tray (**G**) into the box as illustrated.





Step Three: Finally, place the Small Tray (**H**) into the box as illustrated.
