Construction Tips


- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.

Building the Small Character Trays (4x)

This group of 4 trays provides storage for each of your character cards, character ability cards, character boards, standees, minis, and tokens. It is easiest to punch out plates 1–4, build stacks of each type of component, and then build each one.


- 1) Lay base (A) down on your workspace in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the left end tab of inner wall (C) and connect to inner wall (B) and then place glue on the bottom of this structure and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, place glue on the left end tab of inner wall (E) and connect to inner wall (D) and then place glue on the bottom of this structure and connect to base (A). Note that the rounded corners should face inward. {brown}
- **4)** Next, place glue on the end tab of inner wall (**B**) and the bottom of outer wall (**F**) and connect.
- 5) Next, place glue on the end tab of inner wall (E), the bottom and end tabs of end wall (G), and connect.
- **6)** Next, place glue on the end tab of inner wall (**D**) and the bottom of outer wall (**H**) and connect.
- 7) Next, place glue on the end tabs and bottom of end wall (J) and connect.
- 8) Finally, after allowing 5 minutes to dry, place the lid (\mathbf{Z}) on the tray



Building the Large Card Tray

The Large Card Tray is designed to store the large city event cards and supports the paper divider provided with the game, as well as sleeved cards.


- 1) Orient base (K) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the end tabs of base (K) and connect side wall (L). Repeat on the other side.
- 3) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of the structure and connect wall (M). Repeat on the other side with the other wall (M).





Building the Stat Card Tray

The Stat Card Tray provides storage for the monster stat cards and envelopes.

- 1) Orient base (O) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of side wall (N) and connect to wall (P). Repeat on the other side.
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of side walls (N, N) and side tabs of base (O) and connect.
- **4)** Finally, apply glue to all side tabs on the other side and connect the other wall (**P**).











Building Token Tray #1

Token Tray #1 provides storage for the treasure, element, terrain, and trap tokens for use during play.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall
- (B) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (C) and connect. Repeat on the other side with wall (D).
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of wall (F) and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom of wall (E) and connect.
- **6)** Next, apply glue to the side tabs of inner splitters (**G**, **H**) and connect. {green}
- 7) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs of small splitter (I) and connect. {blue}

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, attach lid (\mathbf{Z}) and allow it to dry.




Building Token Tray #2

Token Tray #2 provides storage for the damage, money, and activation tokens for use during play.

- 1) Orient base (J) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (K) and connect to base (J). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of wall (N) and connect. Repeat on the other side with wal (AA).
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (P) and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (O) and connect
- 6) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs of small splitters (L, M) and connect. {blue}

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, attach lid (Y) and allow it to dry.





Building Token Tray #3


Token Tray #3 provides storage for the condition tokens for use during play.


- 1) Orient base (Q) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (R) and connect to base (Q). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (V) and connect. Repeat on the other side with wall (W).
- **4)** Next, apply glue to the bottom of wall **(T)** and connect. Repeat on the other side with wall **(U)**.
- 5) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs of small splitters (S, S, S, S, S) and connect. {red}

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, attach lid (\mathbf{X}) and allow it to dry.












Building the Legacy Tray

The Legacy Tray is designed to store the legacy boxes (unopened), as well as any small cards removed from the game.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B,
- C) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of wall (D) and connect. Repeat on the other side with wall (E).
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (F) and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (G) and connect.
- **6)** Finally, apply glue to the side tabs of splitter **(H)** and connect. {green}







Building the Small Card Tray


The Small Card Tray holds the small cards, sleeved or unsleeved.


- 1) Orient base (J) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (L) and connect to base (J).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of wall (K) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (L) and connect.

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (**Z**) in the tray to ensure a perfect fit once dry.











Building the Top Tray

The Top Tray provides storage for the character pads, element board, monster stands, and bosses.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (B) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of end wall (C) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (D) and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (E) and connect.
- **6)** Finally, apply glue to the bottom of splitter **(F)** and connect. {purple}

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, attach lid (Z) and allow it to dry.

Building the Monster Tray


The Monster Tray is designed to store all monster tokens, except bosses. The included token key will allow for the quick and easy removal of the monster tokens.

Note: pay attention and ensure the etched names are in the proper positions based on the illustration.

- 1) Orient base (G) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of long wall
- (J) and inner wall (H) and connect to base (G). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of wall (L) and connect. Repeat on the other side with wall (N).
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of long wall (M) and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of short wall (O) and connect.
- 6) Next, apply glue to the bottom of wall (P) and connect.
- 7) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of inner walls (\mathbf{R} , \mathbf{R} , \mathbf{R}) and connect. {green}
- 8) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of inner wall (S) and connect. {purple}
- 9) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (K) and connect. {blue}
- 10) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs of inner wall (T) and connect. {red}

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, attach lid (\mathbf{X}) and allow it to dry.


Storing Your Trays in the Box



Step One: Place the four Character Trays (A), three Token Trays (B), Small Card Tray (C), four Character dials (D), Large Card Tray (E), and Stat Tray (F) into the box as illustrated.



Step Two: Place the Legacy Tray (**G**) into the box as illustrated.



Step Four: Place the Top Tray (**I**) into the box as illustrated.



Step Three: Place the Monster Tray (**H**) into the box as illustrated.
