# **Construction Tips**

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our inserts are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.


#### **Building the Card Trays**

You will be constructing two Card Trays.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (C) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom of side wall (B) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (C) and connect.
- 5) Repeat to build the second card tray.

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a couple of dividers (**Z**) in the tray to ensure a perfect fit when dry.







#### **Building the Small Mini Tray**

The Small Mini Tray provides storage for larger minis.

- 1) Place base (D) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Place glue on the side tabs of small inner wall (F) and connect to inner wall (E). {brown}
- **3)** Next, place glue on the bottom of the structure you built in step #2 and connect to base (**D**).
- 4) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (H) and connect to base (D).
- 5) Next, place glue on the bottom of outer wall (**G**) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- **6**) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (H) and connect.








#### **Building the Top Tray**

The Top Tray is designed to hold map tiles.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs
- of end wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom of side wall (C) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (B) and connect.







#### **Building the Large Token Tray**


The Large Token Tray is designed to store tokens.


- 1) Place base (E) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom of end wall (G) and connect.
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of long wall (F) and connect. Repeat on the other side
- **4)** Finally, place glue on the bottom of end wall **(G)** and connect.

Once you determine how to store your tokens, you can glue in the dividers (**Z**).










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
#### **Building the Shallow Mini Trays**

The Shallow Mini Trays will store 10+ minis each. You will be building two Shallow Mini Trays.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of inner wall
- (B) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom of end wall (C) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- **4)** Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (**D**) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 6) Repeat the previous build instructions for the second tray.

Once you determine how to store your minis, you can glue in the dividers (**Z**). You can also use the dividers without gluing them in.






#### **Building the Tall Mini Tray**

The Tall Mini Tray will store 18+ minis and the tray is adjustable, allowing you to store larger minis, as needed.

- 1) Place base (F) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (G) and connect to base (F).
- **3)** Next, place glue on the bottom of side wall (**H**) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- **4)** Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (**G**) and connect.

Once the tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a couple of divider walls (W) to ensure a perfect fit.

It is best to wait until you determine how you want to store all of your minis before gluing in the dividers (W) and splitters (X, Y).



#### Building the LRJ-001 Replacement Token Tray

This Replacement Token Tray can be built and used to replace the small token tray from your LRJ-001 kit. It provides a new inner divider wall to better separate new tokens included in expansions.

- 1) Place base (A) in the orientation noted.
- 2) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B,
- B) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, place glue on the bottom of side wall (C) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- **4)** Finally, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of end wall (**B**) and connect. Repeat on the other side.



## Storing Your Trays in the Box



Step One: Place a Shallow Mini Tray (A), Tall Mini Tray (B), two Card Trays (C), and Small Mini Tray (D) in the box.



Step Two: Next, place a Shallow Mini Tray (E), Large Token Tray (F), and Top Tray (G) in the box. Close the lid!
