Construction Tips

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our organizers are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.


Please reference the diagrams to understand how each component fits together. Also, dry fit the pieces to understand how it goes together and ensure everything is oriented properly before applying glue. Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

Building the Card Trays

The two Card Trays are designed to hold the cards and can be used as card dispensers during the game.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom, side, and top tabs of inner walls (B, B) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of rear wall (C) and
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom, side, and top tabs of outer walls (B, B) and connect.
- 5) Finally, apply glue to the connecting edges of top (Z) and connect with the etched bird visible on top (not pictured on the right.)
- 6) Repeat steps 1 5 and build the other tray.






Building the Food Trays

The Food Trays are designed to hold the food tokens and are intended to be used during play.

- 1) Orient base (E) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom of wall (F) and connect to base (E).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end walls (G, G) and connect.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of wall (F) and connect.
- 5) Allow the glue to set for a few minutes and then place a few dividers (H) in the tray to ensure a perfect fit.
- 6) Repeat steps 1 5 and build the other tray.

Once you decide how you want to split up the food tokens, you may optionally place glue on the bottom of dividers (H) and seat them in the tray permanently.






Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

Building the Egg Tray

The Egg Tray is designed to hold the egg minis.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom of wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end walls (C, C) and connect.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of wall (B) and connect.
- 5) Allow the glue to set for a few minutes and then place the lid (**Z**) on the tray.





Building the Action Cube Tray

The Action Food Tray is designed to hold the action cubes.

- 1) Orient base (E) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (F, F, G, G) and connect to base (E).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (H, H) and connect.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (\mathbf{J}, \mathbf{J}) and connect.
- 5) Allow the glue to set for a few minutes and then place the lid (Y) on the tray.

Storing Your Trays in the Box



Step One: Place the two Card Trays (**A**), the Action Cube Tray (**B**), the Bird House (with dice and small tiles inside) (**C**), and the two Food Token Trays (**D**) stacked on top of each other in the box.

Step Two: Place the five player boards (**E**) into the box on top of the two Card Trays (**A**) on the left side and then stack the Egg Tray (**F**) and the score pads on top of the Action Cube Tray (**B**).





Step Three: Place all your game manuals (**G**) on top of the trays/boards and close the box.
