## **Construction Tips**


- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our organizers are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.

Also, dry fit the pieces to understand how it goes together and ensure everything is oriented properly before applying glue. Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

#### **Building the Token Tray**

The Token Tray is designed to hold all tokens used in the game.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B,
- B) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (D,D),
- the bottom and side tabs of walls (C,C), and connect. {blue}
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls (E,E) and connect.
- 5) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (F,F) and connect.
- **6)** After allowing the glue to dry for a few minutes, place several dividers **(Y)** in the tray and then place the lid **(Z)** on the tray and allow it to fully dry.








#### **Building the Large Minis Tray**

The Large Minis Tray is designed to hold larger minis.

- 1) Orient base (G) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, glue supports (N,N,N,N) to rails (O,O,O,O) and set aside. {red}
- 3) Next, glue support (P) to rail (Q) (pay
- attention to orientation) and set aside. {green}
- 4) Next, apply glue to the two joints that join
- (**L,M**) and then apply glue to the base of the
- structure and connect to base (G). {brown}
- 5) Next, apply glue to the structure (P,Q) and connect to wall (R). {green}
- 6) Next, apply glue to the four rail structures
- (N,O) and connect to walls (S,U). {red}
- 7) Next, apply glue to stop (V) and connect to wall (S). {orange}
- 8) Next, apply glue to bottom and side tabs of short inner walls (J,J), long inner walls (K,K), and cross wall (H) and connect to base (G), while ensuring cross wall (H) is oriented properly.
- **9)** Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (**R**) and connect.
- **10**) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (**S**) and connect.
- 11) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (T) and connect.
- **12)** Finally, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (**U**) and connect.










#### **Building the Map Tile Tray**

The Map Tile Tray is designed to hold map tiles for the base game with some spare room for a few more tiles.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom of wall (B) and connect
- to base (A).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end walls (C, C) and connect.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of wall (B) and connect.








#### **Building the Small Card Tray**


The Small Card Tray is designed to hold the small cards.

- 1) Orient base (E) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (F) and connect to base (E). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (G,G) and connect.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (F,F) and connect.
- 5) Allow the glue to set for a few minutes and then place a few dividers (Z) to ensure a perfect fit once dry.












#### **Building the Large Card Tray**

The Large Card Tray is designed to hold large cards and the jumbo cards.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of walls (B,C), connect wall (B) to inner wall (C), and then connect the structure to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of floor (D) and connect to inner wall (C). {blue}
- 4) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of base (A) where outer walls (E,E) connect, and to the side tabs of inner wall (C), and connect outer walls (E,E).
- 5) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of base (A) where outer wall (F) connects, to the side tabs of outer wall (F), and connect.
- **6)** Finally, apply glue to the side tabs of base (A) where outer wall (G) connects, to the side tabs of outer wall (G), and connect.
- 7) Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (Z) into the tray to ensure a perfect fit once dry.







#### **Building the Small Minis Tray**

The Small Minis Tray is designed to hold smaller minis.

- 1) Orient base (J) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (K,L) and connect to base (J). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (H,H,H), and to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (Q), and then connect splitters (H,H,H) to inner wall (Q), and connect the structure to base (J). {blue}
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitter walls (N,N,N,N) and connect. {orange}
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (R) and connect.
- **6)** Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (**P**) and connect.
- 7) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (M) and connect.
- **8)** Finally, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (**0**) and connect.






#### **Building the Medium Minis Tray**


The Medium Minis Tray is designed to store mediumsized minis.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and left side tabs of splitter (B), the left tabs of floor (C), and connect (B,C,D) together. {orange}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitter (Z), the bottom of walls (E,F), and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of large walls (G,G) and connect. {blue}
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom of the wall (**D**) structure you built in step #2 and connect.
- **6)** Next, apply glue to the side and bottom tabs of outer walls (**JJ**) and connect.
- 7) Next, apply glue to the side and bottom tabs of outer wall (L) and connect.
- 8) Next, apply glue to bottom of front wall (K) and connect.
- 9) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs of splitters (H,H) and connect. {red}



## Storing Your Trays in the Box

**Step One:** Place the Small Card Tray (**A**), the Large Minis Tray (**B**), the Small Minis Tray (**C**), the Large Card Tray (**D**), and the Token Tray (**E**) into the box.



**Step Two:** Place the Medium Minis Tray (**F**) and the Map Tile Tray (**G**) on top of the existing trays and then place the remaining dashboards and the rulebook on top.
