

# HEROQ-001 STORAGE SOLUTION

Organizer Compatible for the 2021 Edition of HeroQuest  
This kit provides storage for cards, minis, tokens, boards, and expansions



## Construction Tips

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our organizers are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) **Always dry fit pieces first** to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.

Also, dry fit the pieces to understand how it goes together and ensure everything is oriented properly before applying glue. Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

## Building the Card Tray

The Card Tray is designed to hold the cards from the base game and the expansions released with it, sleeved or unsleeved.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of end wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of outer walls (D, D) and connect.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of end wall (C) and connect. Logo should face outward.

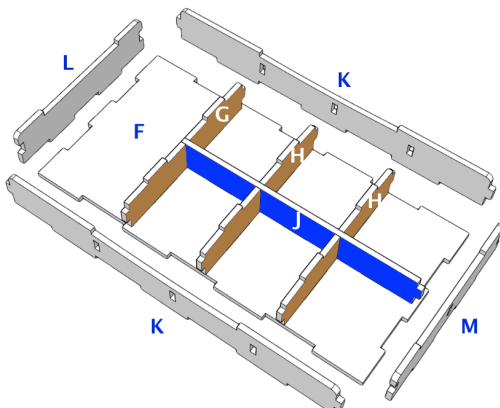
5) Once your card tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (Z) into the tray and allow it to dry overnight.



## Building the Token Tray

The Token Tray provides storage for the cardboard tokens from the base game.

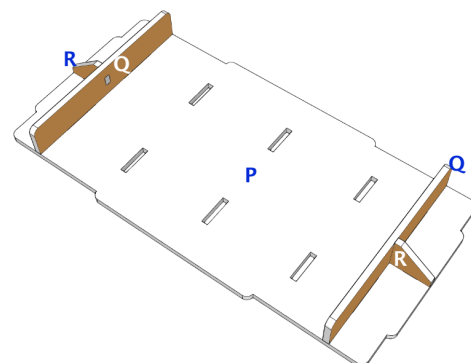
- 1) Orient base (F) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (G, H, H) and connect to base (F). **{brown}**
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitter (J) and connect. **{blue}**
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls (K, K) and connect.
- 5) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of end walls (L, M) and connect.



## Building the Token Tray Lid

The Token Tray Lid provides a lid for the Token Tray and also provides a home for the character sheet pad.

- 1) Orient base (P) as illustrated.
- 2) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of support (R) and connect to wall (Q) and then apply glue to the bottom of the structure and connect to base (P). **{brown}**
- 3) Repeat on the other side.

## Building Large Mini Tray #1

Large Mini Tray #1 is designed to store the dice and minis from the base game. This tray has a recess to store large tiles and game manuals.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B, B, B, B) and connect to base (A). **{brown}**
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of inner walls (E, E, E, C, D) and connect. **{blue}**
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (F, F, F, F) and connect. **{green}**
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom of splitter (G) and connect. **{orange}**
- 6) Next, apply glue to the bottom and end tabs of outer walls (H, H) and connect.
- 7) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of end walls (K, J) and connect.



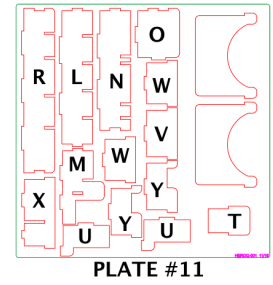
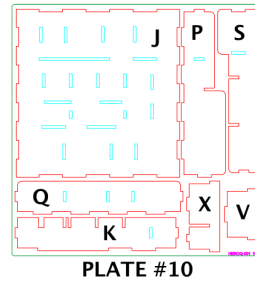
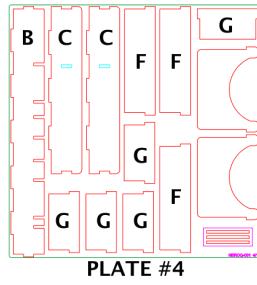
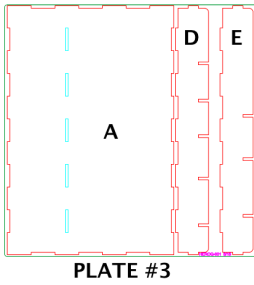
## Building Large Mini Tray #2

Large Mini Tray #2 is designed to store the minis from the base game. This tray has a recess to store blue tiles and game manuals.

- 1) Orient base (M) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (N, O, P, R) and connect to base (M). **{brown}**
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (S, S, T, T) and connect. **{green}**
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (U, V, V) and connect. The second "V" piece is on plate #2. **{blue}**
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls (W, W) and connect.
- 6) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of end walls (X, Y) and connect.

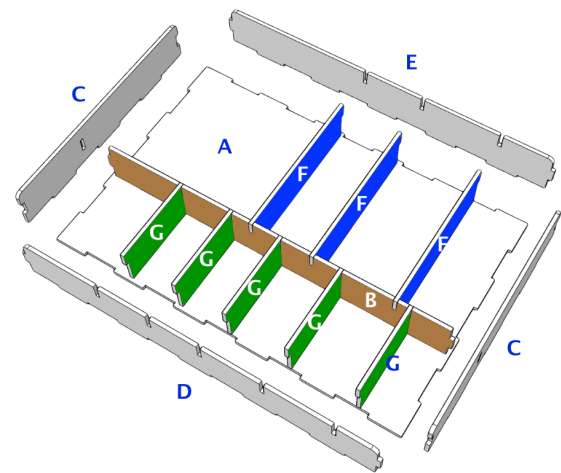

## Building Large Mini Tray #3

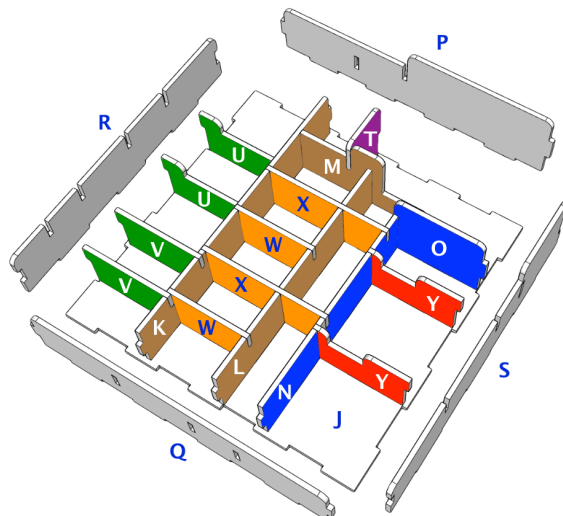
Large Minis Tray #3 is designed to store the landscape minis.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (B) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of end walls (C, C) and connect to base.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls (D, E) and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (G, G, G, G, G) and connect to base. {green}
- 6) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (F, F, F) and connect. {blue}



## Building Small Mini Tray #1

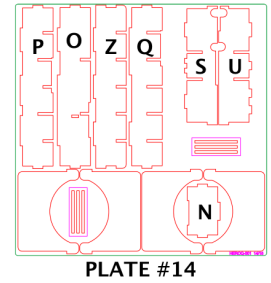
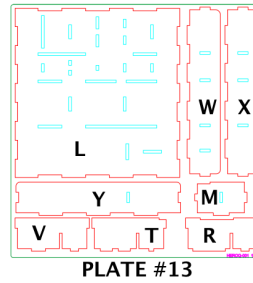
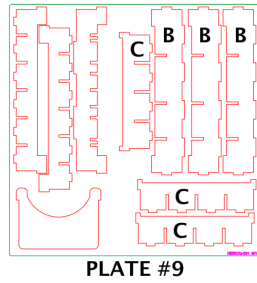
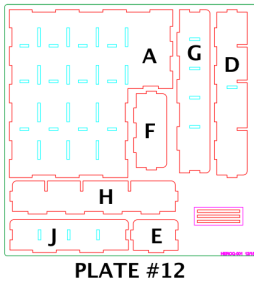
Small Mini Tray #1 is designed to store Mythic expansion minis and more.



- 1) Orient base (J) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (K, L, M) and connect to base (J). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (N, O) and connect to base. {blue}
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls (P, Q) and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (R, S) and connect.
- 6) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (U, U, V, V) and connect. {green}
- 7) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (W, W, X, X) and connect. {orange}
- 8) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (Y, Y) and connect. {red}
- 9) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitter (T) and connect. {purple}

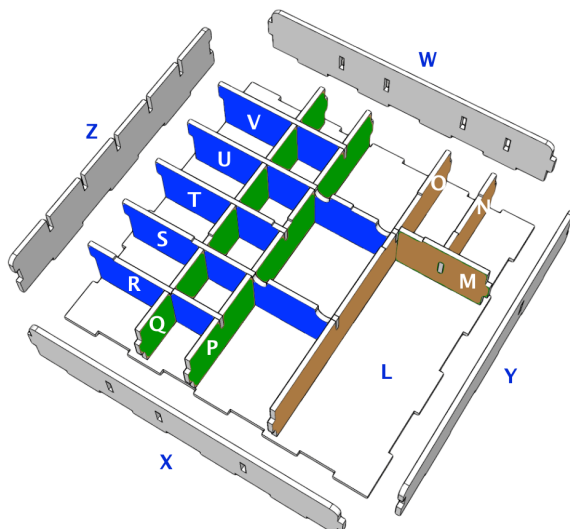
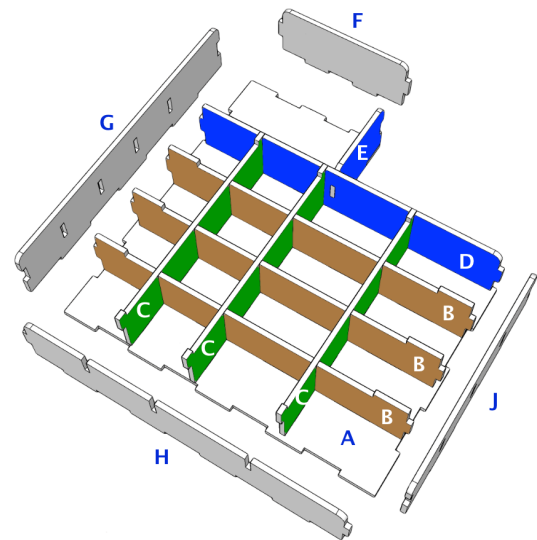

## Building Small Mini Tray #2

Small Mini Tray #2 is designed to store expansion minis and tokens. This tray has a cutout on top for large tiles.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B, B, B) and connect to base (A). **{brown}**
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of splitters (C, C, C) and connect to base (A). **{green}**
- 4) Next, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of walls (D, E), connect them together, and then connect to base. **{blue}**
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (F) and connect.
- 6) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (G, J) and connect.
- 7) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (H) and connect.



## Building Small Mini Tray #3

Small Mini Tray #3 is designed to store expansion minis and tokens. This tray has a slight recess on top to store the long dungeon tile.

- 1) Orient base (L) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (M, N, O), join them together, and connect to base (L). **{brown}**
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (P, Q) and connect. **{green}**
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (R, S, T, U, V) and connect. **{blue}**
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls (W, X) and connect.
- 6) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (Y, Z) and connect.

# Storing Your Trays in the Box

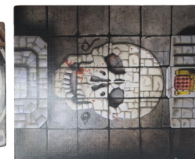
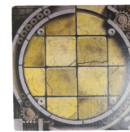
## Step One:

Place the Card Tray (A), Small Mini Tray #1 (B), and Large Mini Tray #2 (C) into the box. Then place several game manuals and the tile below in the tray cutout in Large Mini Tray #2 (C).



## Step Two:

Next, place the Large Mini Tray #1 (D), Small Mini Tray #2 (E), and Token Tray (F), including character pad, into the box. Then place the two tiles below in the tray cutout of Small Mini Tray #2 (E).



## Step Three:

Finally, place the Large Mini Tray #3 (H) and Small Mini Tray #3 (G) into the box. Then place the tile below in the diagonal cutout in Small Mini Tray #3 (G). Then place the board and screen on top of the trays (not pictured) and close the box.
