Construction Tips


- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our organizers are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.

Building the Cardboard Tray

The Cardboard Tray is designed to hold villain dashboards.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (C). Repeat on
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall




Building the Card Tray #1

Card Tray #1 offers eleven (11) thicker card storage slots and nine (9) hero deck slots.

- 1) Orient base (H) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (J) and connect to base (H).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (K) and connect. Repeat on the other side. Ensure you orient the walls properly with the wider slots to the same end.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (J) and connect.

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (Z) in the tray to ensure a perfect fit, once dry.





Building the Card Tray #2

Card Tray #2 is designed to store hero decks and offers twenty-three (23) hero storage slots.


- 1) Orient base (H) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall
- (J) and connect to base (H).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (L) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (I) and connect.


Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a few dividers (Z) in the tray to ensure a perfect fit, once dry.














Building the Short Mini Trays

The two Short Mini Trays are designed to hold as many as 16 minis each.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (C) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (B) and connect.
- 5) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of the inner walls (**D**, **D**, **D**) and place into the tray.
- **6)** Finally, place the splitters (**Z**) into the tray. You can glue them in once you decide what to store in the tray.

Repeat build steps above to complete the second tray.








Building the Tall Mini Tray

The Tall Mini Tray is designed to hold as many as 16 minis, with larger bases.

- 1) Orient base (F) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (G) and connect to base (F).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (**H**) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (K) and connect.
- 5) Next, place glue on the bottom and side tabs of the inner walls (J, J, L) and place into the tray.
- **6)** Finally, place the splitters **(Y)** into the tray. You can glue them in once you decide what to store in the tray.










Building the Large Token Tray

The Large Token Tray is designed to store tokens from the expansions and KS Extras.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- **3)** Next, apply glue to the bottom of the outer wall **(C)** and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (B) and connect to base (A).
- 5) Next, place some splitters (X) in the tray. You can glue these in once you decide what to store in the tray.
- **6)** Finally, place the lid on the tray **(Y)** and allow it to dry overnight.





Building the Small Token Tray

The Small Token Tray is designed to store tokens from the expansions and KS Extras.

- 1) Orient base (E) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (F) and connect to base (E).
- **3)** Next, apply glue to the bottom of the outer wall (**G**) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (F) and connect to base (E).
- 5) Next, place some splitters (W) in the tray. You can glue these in once you decide what to store in the tray.
- **6)** Finally, place the lid on the tray (**Z**) and allow it to dry overnight.

Step One:

Place Card Tray #1 (A) and then Tall Mini Tray (B) in the box.



Step Three:

Next, place the Short Mini Tray #2 (E) into the box.





Step Two:

Next, place the Short Mini Tray #1 (C) and Card Tray #2 (D) in the box.



Step Four:

Finally, place the Cardboard Tray (\mathbf{F}), Short Token Tray #3 (\mathbf{G}), and Long Token Tray (\mathbf{H}) into the box. Close the box!
