# **Construction Tips**


- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our organizers are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.

Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

#### **Building the 5 Part Token Trays**

The two 5 Part Token Trays are designed to hold various tokens including player components.


- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B, B, C, C) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (D) and connect.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom tabs of outer wall (E) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (D) and connect.
- **6)** Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (**G**, **G**, **F**, **F**) and connect. {blue}
- 7) Repeat steps #1 #6 to build the second tray.



#### **Building the Card Trays**

The three card trays are designed to hold the cards used in the game. This kit includes dividers and supports sleeved cards. Card trays can be used on the board during play. Note: one of your card trays should have the etched logo wall facing outward.


- 1) Orient base (H) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (I) and connect to base (H).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (J) and connect. Repeat on the other side.  $\label{eq:connect}$
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (I) and connect.
- 5) Repeat steps #1 #4 to build the other two trays. Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place a divider (Z)




#### **Building the Large Misc Tray**

The Large Misc Tray is designed to store the Moon Staff and the Red Moon Staff.

- 1) Orient base (L) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (M) and connect to base (L).
- **3)** Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (**0**) and connect. Repeat on the other side with outer wall (**N**).
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of end wall (P) and connect.
- 5) Finally, apply some glue to the angled corners where outer walls (O, N, P) join to further stabilize the walls.











#### **Building the Site Tiles Tray**

The Site Tiles Tray is designed to store the Site Tiles both during play and storage.


- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B1, B2, C, C, C, C) and connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls (E, E), the side tabs of false floor (F), and the bottom of end walls (J, J) and connect.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls (D, D), the side tabs of false floor (G), and the bottom of end walls (H, H) and connect.



#### **Building the Small Token Tray**

The Small Token Tray is designed to hold the Jewel tokens during play. This tray is designed to rest inside the Large Token Tray during storage and can be placed on the Supply board during play.

- 1) Orient base (L) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (M) and connect to base (L).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (N) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (M) and connect.




#### **Building the Small Tray**

The Small Tray is designed to store the 5 Blocking tiles.

- 1) Orient base (P) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (Q) and connect to base (P).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (R) and connect. Repeat on the other side.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (Q) and connect.

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place the lid (Z) on it and allow to dry overnight.








#### **Building the Assistant Tiles Tray**

The Assistant Tiles Tray is designed to hold the Assistant Tiles and is designed to be placed on the Supply board during play.


- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (F, F, F, F).
- 4) Next, apply glue to the notch where space end (E) and spacer base (D) slide together and connect, and then place glue on the tabs of piece (E, D) and connect to end wall (C). Repeat on the other side.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of the structures you just built in step #4 and connect to base (A).
- **6)** Finally, apply glue to the outer walls (**G**, **G**, **G**, **G**) and connect.




#### **Building the Large Token Tray**

The Large Token Tray is designed to hold the Arrowhead, Tablet, Compass, Coin tokens, and the Small Token Tray and is designed to rest on the Supply board during play.

- 1) Orient base (J) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (K, M, M, L) and connect to base (J). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (O, O) and connect.
- **4)** Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end walls (**N, N**) and connect.
- 5) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs and bottom of inner walls (P, Q) and connect. {cyan}

The two SPACERS on this plate on the left are used to create a stable storage area for your scorepad in the box. Don't throw them out.



#### **Building the Solo Tile Tray**

The Solo Tile Tray is designed to hold the Solo Tiles.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B, B) and connect. {brown}
- **3)** Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls (**C**, **C**) and connect.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of short outer walls (D, D, D, D) and connect.




#### **Building the Temple Tiles Tray**

The Temple Tiles Tray offers storage for your temple tiles and can be used during play and is designed to be placed on the Main board during play.

- 1) Orient base (F) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (G), short outer walls (H, H) and connect to base (F). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (J), short inner walls (K, K) and connect to base (F). {blue}
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (L, L, M, N, N) and connect. {cyan}
  5) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of end walls (O, O,

P, P, P, P) and connect.



# **Storage Instructions**

#### Step One:

Place the three Card Trays (A), all Expedition Leader boards except Mystic (B), one 5 Part Token Tray (C), and the Site Tiles Tray (D) in the box.





#### **Step Two:**

Next, place the Temple Tiles Tray (E), Large Misc Tray (F), the Large Token Tray and then the last 5 Part Token Tray stacked together (G), Solo Tile Tray (H), and Assistant Tiles Tray (I) in the box.

#### **Step Three:**

Next, place two stacks of two each player boards (J, J) in the box.





#### Step Four:

Next, place the Research Track board (K) and the Mystic Expedition Leader board (L) in the box.

#### **Step Five:**

Next, place the Supply board (M) and then the scorepad (N) in the box. You can optionally place the two small spacers around the scorepad, as needed.





#### Step Six:

Finally, place the Main board and then the game manuals  $(\mathbf{O})$  in the box and close the lid.
