# **MD2-001 STORAGE SOLUTION**

Organizer Compatible with Massive Darkness 2 base game

This kit provides storage for cards, tokens, tiles, minis, and boards. One base game mini will need to be stored in another organizer within this line of organizers due to size constraints.



## **Construction Tips**


- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our organizers are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.







### **Build Instructions**










Please reference the diagrams to understand how each component fits together. Also, dry fit the pieces to understand how it goes together and ensure everything is oriented properly before applying glue. Finally, cleanup excess glue to ensure a proper fit and finish, especially in card, rail, and tray storage areas.

#### **Building the Main Insert**


The Main Insert is designed to hold map tiles, larger cardboard, large cards, heroes, and a couple of enemy leaders. All number etching should face inwards so that the etchings can be read by simply looking into the tray while it is in the box.


- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of wall supports (L, L, L), floor (M), and connect front wall (K) to outer wall (J). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B, C) and connect to base (A), then apply glue to floor (E) and front wall (D) and connect to inner wall (B). {blue}
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (J) and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (F) and connect.
- 6) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (H) and connect.
- 7) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (**G**) and connect.
- 8) Finally, apply glue to the side tabs of splitters (N, N, O, P, P, P) and connect. {green}


Once your insert has had a few minutes to dry, place the lid (Z) on the tile tray area and allow the insert to dry overnight.





#### **Building the Card Tray**

The Card Tray is designed to store both large and small cards, sleeved or unsleeved. We also like to keep our extra dice in this tray. The end and center walls of this design have a higher and a lower side. Pay attention when building as the lower walls should all be on the right side.


- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls
- (B, C) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (D, D) and connect.
- **4)** Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end walls (**E, F**) and connect.



#### **Building the Short Mini Tray**

The Short Mini Tray is designed to hold groups of small minis. Once you decide how to store your minis, you can glue in the name tabs on plate #13.


- 1) Orient base (G) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (H) and connect to base (G).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls  $(\mathbf{J},\,\mathbf{J})$  and connect.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (H) and connect.
- 5) Finally, place inner walls (K, K, K) and allow the tray to dry, but do not glue yet! {blue}
- **6)** Once your tray has dried, you can determine how you want to store your minis and then you can glue the inner walls (**K**, **K**, **K**) and splitters (**X**), as needed.




#### **Building the Tall Mini Trays**


The Tall Mini Trays are designed to hold groups of small minis. You will build 2x trays using these instructions. Once you decide how to store your minis, you can glue in the name tabs on plate #13.


- 1) Orient base (M) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (N) and connect to base (M).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (O, O) and
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (N) and connect.
- 5) Finally, place inner walls (P, P, P) and allow the tray to dry, but do not glue yet! {blue}
- 6) Once your tray has dried, you can determine how you want to store your minis and then you can glue the inner walls (P, P, P) and splitters (W), as needed.





#### **Building the Jumbo Minis Tray**

The Jumbo Minis Tray is designed to store seven of the larger minis in the base game. Note that the Archangel Michael must be stored in one of the expansion organizers. Minis storage areas are marked based on the number on the bottom of the mini.


- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to one side of the supports (D, D, D, B, B, G,
- G, G) and attach the rails (E, E, F, F, C, C, H, H, H) to the supports.
- 3) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of supports (J, K, L, M) and connect to outer walls (Q1, N).
- 4) Next, apply glue to the side tabs of the structures you built in step #2 (DE, DE, DF, DF, BC, BC, GH, GH, GH) and connect to outer walls (Q1, N, P, Q2).
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (Q1) and connect to base (A).
- **6)** Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (**P**) and connect. Repeat on the other side with outer wall (**N**).
- 7) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (Q2) and connect.



#### **Building the Long Token Tray**

The Long Token Tray is designed to hold all tokens other than the tokens stored in the small token tray (to the right).


- 1) Orient base (R) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (S) and connect to base (R).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (T, T) and connect.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (S) and connect.
- 5) Finally, place all inner walls (U1) and allow the tray to dry, but do not glue yet! {brown}
- 6) Once your tray has dried, you can determine how you want to store your tokens and then you can glue the inner walls (U1) and splitters (U2), as needed. {brown} {blue}



#### **Building the Small Token Tray**

The Small Token Tray is designed to hold the health, mana, and fire/frost tokens, and is stored inside the Jumbo Minis Tray.

- 1) Orient base (V) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall
- (X), inner/outer wall (W), and inner wall (Y) and connect to base (V). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (**Z2**) and connect.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of end wall (Z3) and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (Z) and connect.
- **6)** Finally, apply glue to the bottom of end wall **(Z1)** and connect.



## **Storage Instructions**

#### **Step One:**

Place the Main Insert (A) in the box.





#### **Step Two:**

Next, place the Jumbo Minis Tray + Small Token Tray (B), Long Token Tray (C), and the Short Mini Tray (D) in the box.



#### **Step Three:**

Finally, place the two Tall Mini Trays (E, F), the Card Tray (G), and then finally the game manual on top of the trays and close the box.
