Construction Tips


- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our organizers are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.




Building the Main Insert

The Main Insert is designed to hold minis and large/small cards. The map tiles in this expansion should be stored on top of these trays. All etchings and logos should face into the box in a manner that allows you to easily read them while looking for minis. You will want to dry fit everything to ensure proper logo and etching orientation.


The eight map tiles may be placed on top of the trays. This will contribute 20mm of lid lift. You can also store your map tiles in a spare box such as the Rainbox Crossing box, which will be empty if you are Kickstarter all–in using our solutions.


- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (C, C, D) and connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B, E, F, G, H) and connect. {brown}
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls (K, M) and connect.
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (L, J) and connect.
- 6) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (O, P, P, N, R, Q) and connect. {blue}

Once your main insert has had a few minutes to dry, place several dividers (large and small) into the card tray to ensure a perfect fit once dry.



Building the Large Card Tray

The Large Card Tray is designed to store jumbo cards and one set of six minions.


- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall
- (B) and then connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (C, C) and connect.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls $(\mathbf{D},\,\mathbf{D})$ and connect.



Building the Small Token Tray

The Small Token Tray is designed to store the Cerberus, Rainbow, and Plague/Famine/War tokens.

- 1) Orient base (F) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (G) and connect to base (F). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of end walls $(\mathbf{H},\,\mathbf{H})$ and connect.
- **4)** Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls (J, K) and connect.
- 5) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (L, M) and connect. {green}
