
Construction Tips


- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our organizers are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) Always dry fit pieces first to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.


Building the Small Character Trays (10x)

The Small Character Trays are designed to store the character board, cards, and tokens for each small mini character.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B, C, D) and then connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (F) and connect.
- **4)** Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (**E, G**) and connect. **Note:** logo should face outward.
- 5) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (H) and connect.

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, apply lid (Z) and allow the tray to dry overnight. This will ensure a snug lid fit once the tray has dried.







Building the Medium Character Tray (1x)


The Medium Character Tray is designed to store the character board, cards, and tokens for the medium mini character.


- 1) Orient base (J) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (K, L, N) and then connect to base (J). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (P) and connect.
- **4)** Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (**O**, **Q**) and connect. **Note:** logo should face outward.
- 5) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (\mathbf{R}) and connect.

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, apply lid (**Z**) and allow the tray to dry overnight. This will ensure a snug lid fit once the tray has dried.












Building the Large Character Trays (3x)

The Large Character Trays are designed to store the character board, cards, and tokens for each large mini character.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B, C, D) and then connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (F) and connect.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (E, G) and connect. Note: logo should face outward.
- 5) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (H) and connect.

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, apply lid (**Z**) and allow the tray to dry overnight. This will ensure a snug lid fit once the tray has dried.






Building the Condition Tray

The Condition Tray is designed to store condition tokens and other tokens as needed.

- 1) Orient base (J) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (K, L, L, L) and then connect to base (J). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end walls (N, N) and connect.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (M, M) and connect.

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, apply lid (Y) and allow the tray to dry overnight. This will ensure a snug lid fit once the tray has dried.








Building the Pad Tray

The Pad Tray is designed to store the character sheet/party pads and the terrain tokens.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (B, C, D, D) and then connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer walls (E, E) and connect.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom of end walls (\mathbf{F},\mathbf{G}) and connect.







Building the Large Card Tray


The Large Card Tray is designed to store the large cards, sleeved or unsleeved.

- 1) Orient base (J) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (K) and then connect to base (J).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (L, L) and connect.
- **4)** Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (**K**) and connect.

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place several dividers (**Z**) into the card tray to ensure a perfect fit once dry.










Building the Small Card Tray

The Small Card Tray is designed to store small cards, sleeved or unsleeved.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (B) and then connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end walls $(\mathbf{C},\,\mathbf{C})$ and connect.
- **4)** Finally, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (**B**, **B**) and connect.

Once your tray has had a few minutes to dry, place several small dividers (**not shown**) into the card tray to ensure a perfect fit once dry.







Building the Tall Thin Tray

The Tall Thin Tray is designed to provide storage for Gloomhaven components used during scenarios.

- 1) Orient base (E) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (F) and connect to base (E).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of end walls (G, G) and connect.
- **4)** Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (**F**) and connect.








Building the Monster Tray

The Monster Tray is designed to store the monster tokens and the standee bases.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner wall (B) and then connect to base (A). {brown}
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end walls (C, C) and connect.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (D, F) and connect.
- 5) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of splitters (E, E, E, E) and connect.. {blue}

We have provided a couple of tile keys on plate #9 to assist with removing tiles from this and other trays.





Building the Large Tray


The Large Tray is designed to provide storage for Gloomhaven components used during scenarios.

- 1) Orient base (H) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (J) and then connect to base (H).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom of end walls (K, K) and connect.
- 4) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of outer wall (J) and then connect.

Storage Instructions

Step One:

Place the ten (10x) Small Character Trays (A), the Medium Character Tray (B), the three (3x) Large Character Trays (C), the Small Card Tray (D), the Large Card Tray (E), the Large Tray (F), the Tall Thin Tray (G), and the Condition Tray (H) into the box.





Step Two:

Next, place the Monster Tray (J) and the Pad Tray (K) into the box.

Step Three:

Finally, place the three game manuals across the top of the trays such that the spiral binding of each manual is laying on top of the trays and close the box lid.
