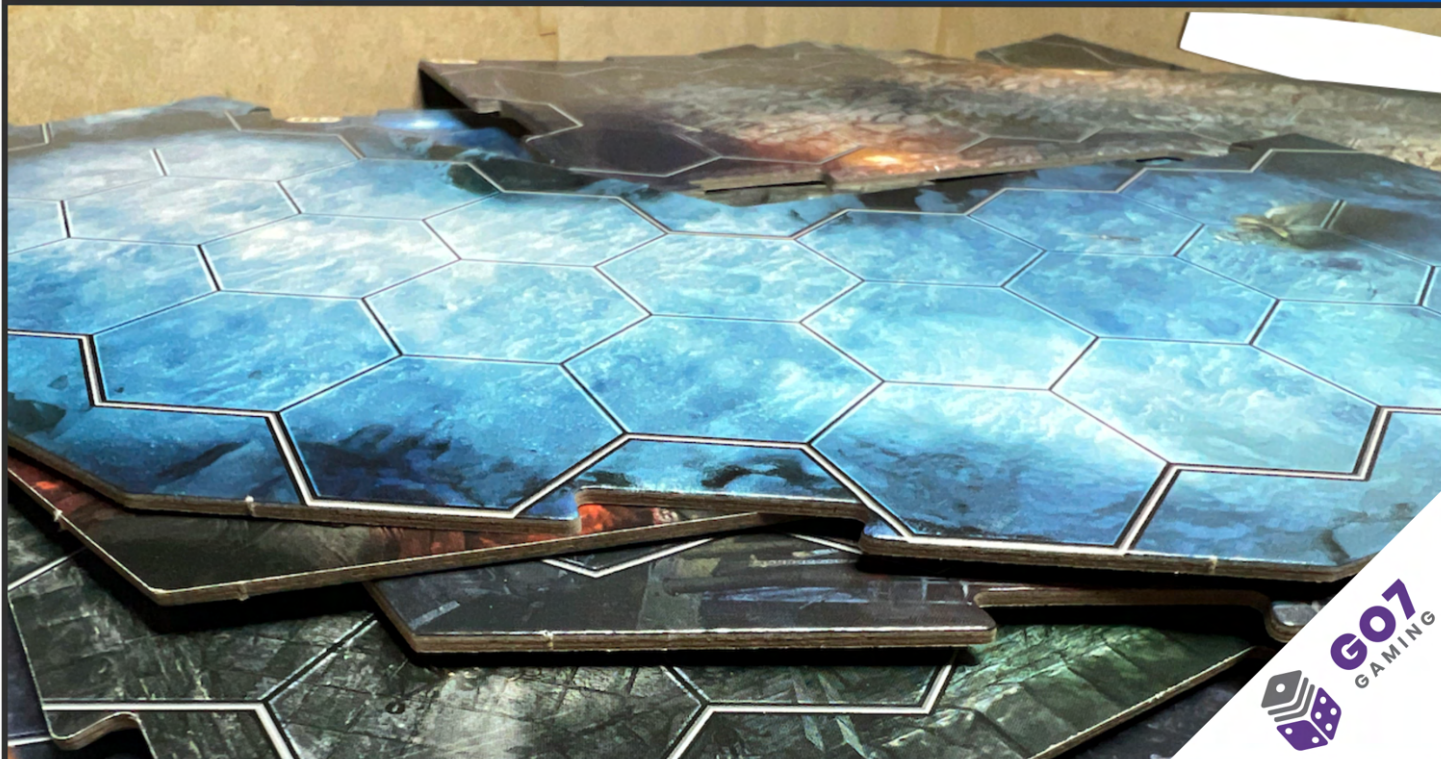


FH-002 STORAGE SOLUTION

Top Tray Organizer Compatible with Frosthaven

This kit provides storage for map tiles and is designed to be used with our FH-001 organizer for Frosthaven



Construction Tips

- 1) Each piece should be removed from the frames with gentle pressure back and forth. You should not need a knife to cut pieces free.
- 2) Our organizers are designed to be glued together. We use Sobo craft glue, but any glue that is tacky and dries clear will work fine. Tacky glue assists with building as it holds better during construction. You can use painter's/masking tape for some joins, but glue is always best.
- 3) Ensure you cleanup excess glue as you build. This is especially important in card lanes where dividers will be used or in spaces where a tray will be stored.
- 4) Check the build diagrams included in the package for reference, including all parts, as well as build tips specific to this insert.
- 5) **Always dry fit pieces first** to ensure a good fit and to better understand how the kit goes together.
- 6) Allow your finished insert to dry overnight.
- 7) You can optionally sand and even stain your insert.

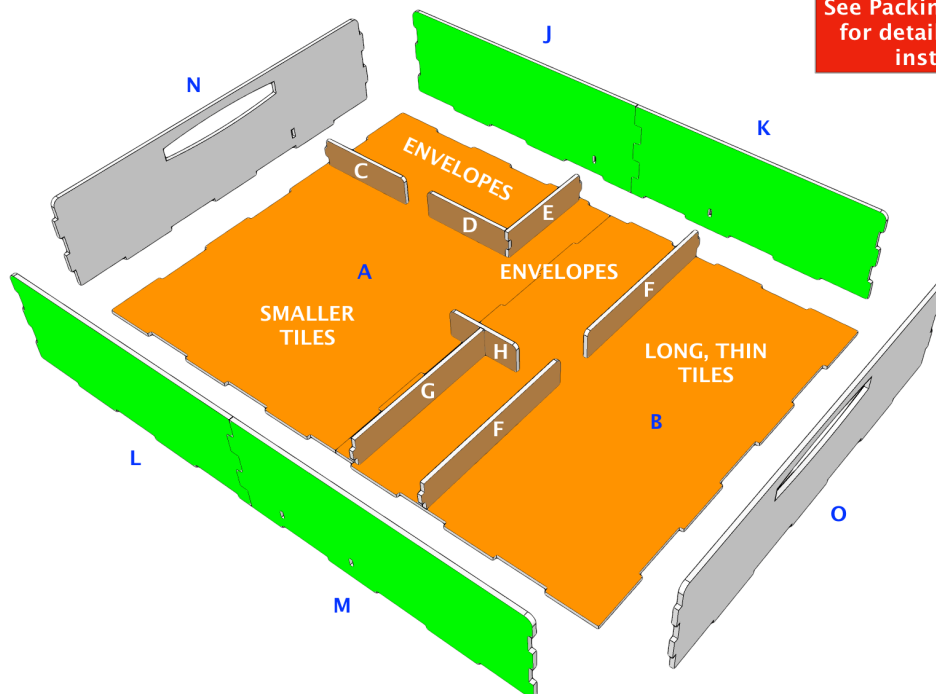
Please reference the diagrams to understand how each component fits together. Also, dry fit the pieces to understand how it goes together and ensure everything is oriented properly before applying glue. Building the Top Tray

The Top Tray is designed to store the map tiles, game board, game manual (non-spiral), and other smaller play boards.

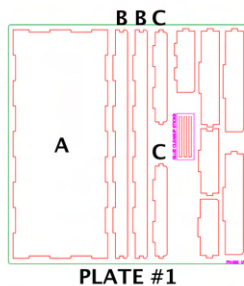
- 1) Glue base (A) and base (B) together and then allow to dry for a few hours. It can be beneficial to place a large object on top of the base while it dries to ensure a perfect fit. A box of Frosthaven is an ideal object for this purpose. Please ensure you protect your box (or other heavy object) from the glue. {orange}
- 2) Next, glue outer walls (J, K) and outer walls (L, M) together and allow to dry for a few hours. It can be beneficial to place a large object on top of the walls while they dry to ensure a perfect fit. A box of Frosthaven is an ideal object for this purpose. Please ensure you protect your box (or other heavy object) from the glue. {green}
- 3) Next, orient base (AB) as illustrated. {orange}
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of inner walls (C, D, E, F, F, G, H) and then connect to base (AB). {brown}
- 5) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (N) and connect to base (AB).
- 6) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer walls (JK, LM) and connect.
- 7) Finally, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end wall (O) and connect. **Note:** logo should face outward.

Allow your tray to dry overnight before loading the tray. It is important that the glue be allowed to cure fully.

Build Instructions

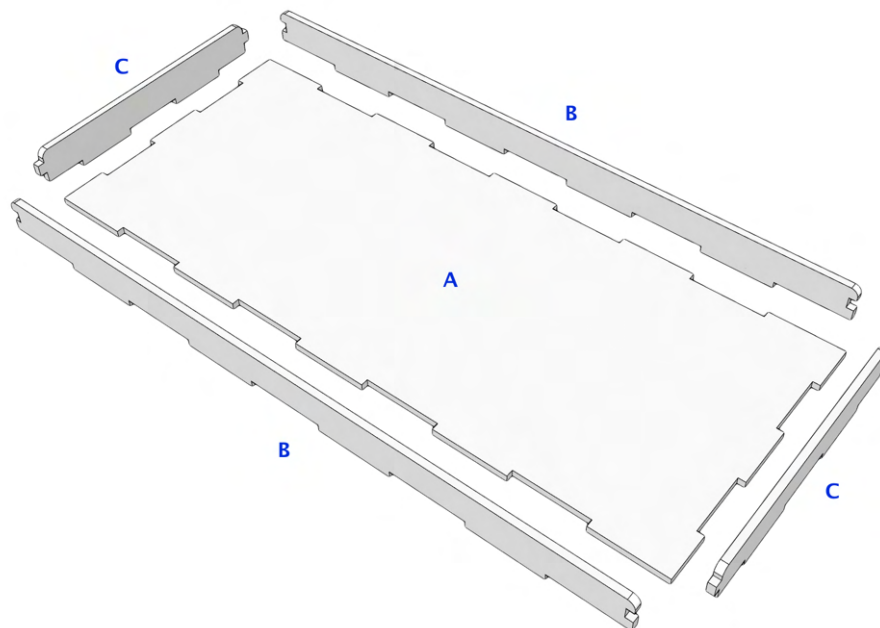


Please reference the diagrams to understand how each component fits together. Building the Medium Tray

The Medium Tray is designed primarily to stabilize the Top Tray. We use it to store in-play items and the puzzle book.

- 1) Orient base (A) as illustrated.
- 2) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (B) and then connect to base (A).
- 3) Next, apply glue to the bottom and side tabs of end walls (C, C) and connect.
- 4) Next, apply glue to the bottom of outer wall (B) and connect.



Packing the Top Tray

Step One:

A: Place map tiles 07-A/C/E/G and 01-A/C/E/G in area (A).

B: Evenly split the envelopes into two stacks and place them in the top tray envelope areas (B).

C: Place map tiles 05-A, 04-A/C, 02-A/C/E/G/I/K, and the element board in area (C).



Step Two:

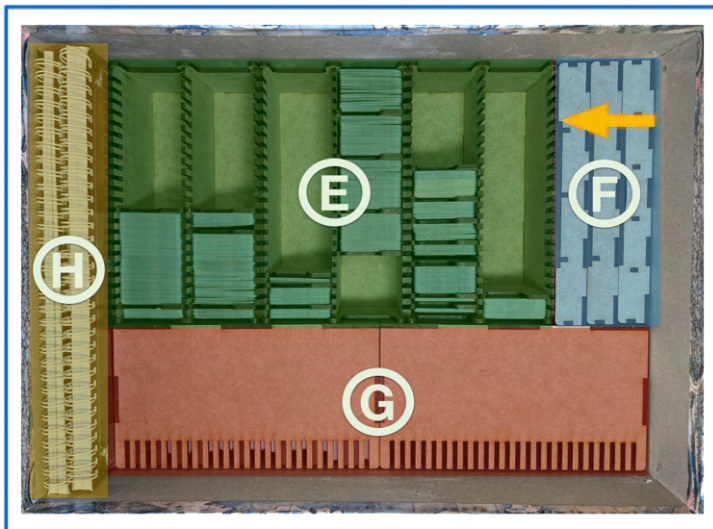
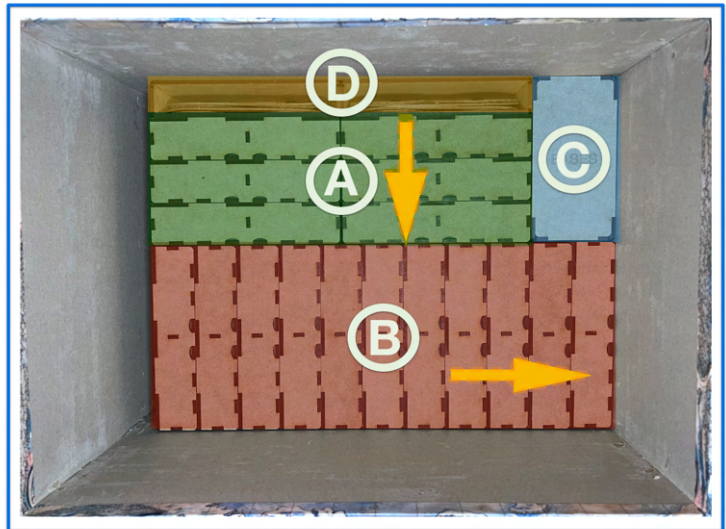
D: Place the remaining large map tiles into the Top Tray working to not overlap them, if possible. Then place the game board, rulebook, and any other 8.5 x 11" sheets on top.

Storage Instructions with Top Tray I

Step One:

Place the six (6x) starting class Character Trays (A), the eleven (11x) other Character Trays (B), then from bottom to top Terrain Tray #2, Terrain Tray #1, Small Token Tray, and the Stand Tray (C), and finally the two (2x) Dial Trays (D) into the box.

When placing lidded trays into the box, note the orientation arrows. This will ensure your lids will stay closed as you pack and unpack trays, assuming you unpack your box in the opposite order that you packed it.



Step Two:

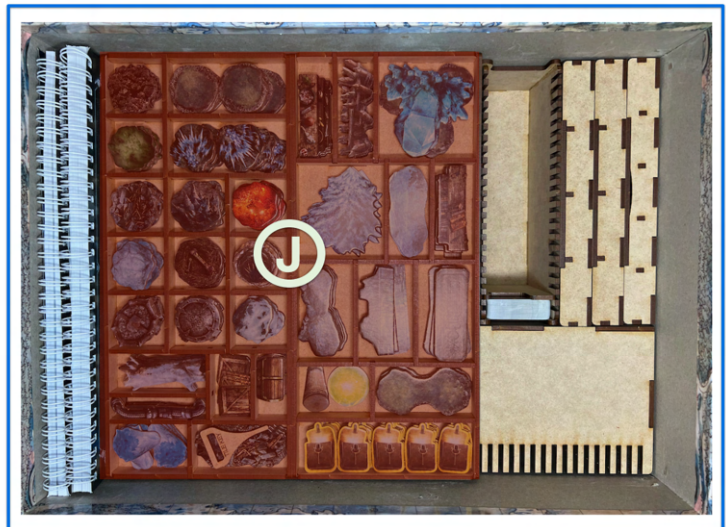
Next, place the three (3x) Small Card Trays (E), then from right to left the Damage Tray, Condition Tray #1, and then Condition Tray #2 (F), two (2x) Large Card Trays (G), and the two (2x) spiral manuals (H) into the box.

The spiral manuals should slowly and carefully be placed one by one into the box.

When placing lidded trays into the box, note the orientation arrows. This will ensure your lids will stay closed as you pack and unpack trays, assuming you unpack your box in the opposite order that you packed it.

Step Three:

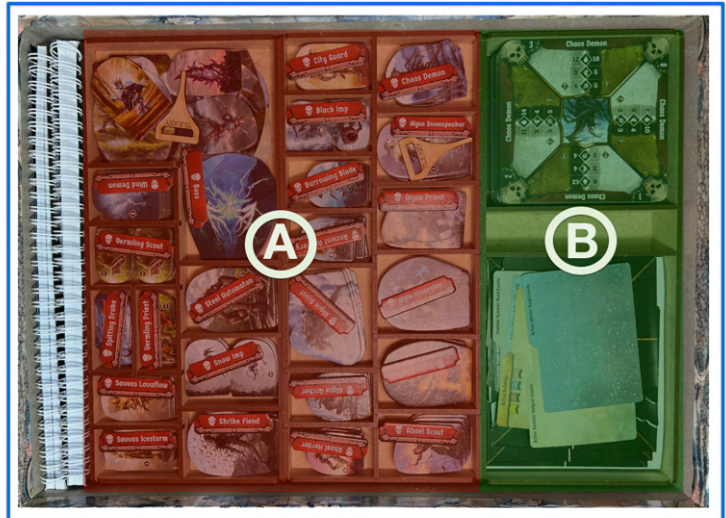
Next, place the two Large Terrain Trays (J) into the box.



Storage Instructions with Top Tray II

Step Four:

Next, place two Monster Trays (A) and the Stat Card Tray (B) into the box.



Step Five:

Next, place the Medium Tray (C) and the last two (2x) Monster Trays (D) into the box.

Step Six:

Finally, place the Top Tray (E) into the box and then place the Scenario Flowcharts and other smaller sheets of stickers and papers into the box and close the box lid.
